**AHI Connects | Petrohué Waterfalls.**

Admire the roaring waterfalls and lush, snowcapped volcanic landscape along the Petrohué River as you navigate through stunning Lake Todos los Santos. Indulge in an authentic Patagonian barbecue with wine at a local restaurant.

**Santiago.** Explore this sophisticated city surrounded by the Andes on a scenic panoramic tour that highlights important city sites. Visit the Museo Chilena de Art Precolombino to see pre-Columbian artworks. Then, take a special tour of a traditional Chilean winery, founded in 1856, and sample their one-of-a-kind wines.

**Calbuco, Puerto Montt.** Savor a special *curanto* lunch in this small fishing village, where fresh seafood, meat and vegetables are cooked on red hot stones in the ground.

**Chiloé Island.** Ferry across the Chacao Channel to this remote, picturesque island. Admire Chacao's pretty town square, then take a boat ride to observe penguins and other wildlife near their natural habitats. In Ancud, visit the Museum of the Churches of Chiloé to see miniature versions of these UNESCO World Heritage site churches.

**Balmaceda and Serrano Glaciers.**

Embark on a small ship for a cruise on the Ultima Esperanza Fjord. Marvel at vistas of waterfalls, mountains and Patagonian birds, then view the Balmaceda, an impressive hanging glacier. Walk through the lush Bernardo O'Higgins National Park to see the spiky Serrano glacier nestled above a lake where tiny icebergs float. Indulge in a special lunch at a local Patagonian ranch.

**Torres del Paine National Park.** Wild, spectacular scenery awaits you on a scenic drive to the acclaimed UNESCO Biosphere Reserve national park. Marvel at the Horns of Paine mountain range and the blue, glacial Lake Grey; then take a short walk to the magnificent Salto Grande waterfall.

**Punta Arenas.** Take a panoramic tour of this historic, sprawling port city with wool-boom mansions on the Strait of Magellan. Enjoy some free time for lunch on your own.
