

Day 7 | Würzburg

Discover Passau. Stroll the old town to see the Bishops' Residences and Niedernburg Monastery; and visit St. Stephen's Cathedral to witness its famous 18,000-pipe organ.





Free Time: Discover more of Passau at leisure.

Day 12 | Melk, Austria | Dürnstein

Melk Abbey. Visit this baroque architectural jewel to admire the opulent interiors, stunning library and spectacular views from the terrace.
