A World of Discovery

Connects | *Glen Keen Farm.* Watch border collies maneuver a flock of sheep on a family-owned Connemara farm.

Ennis. Take a guided walk through this lively market town founded in the 11th century.

The Burren and Cliffs of Moher. Follow expert Tony Kirby on an informative walk across the Burren's arresting and unusual karstic limestone landscape. Admire the portal tomb, Poulnabrone, from 2500–2000 B.C., and marvel at the dramatic Cliffs of Moher, rising 700 feet over the Atlantic.

Aran Island of Inishmore. Ferry across Galway Bay to this starkly beautiful island, where Gaelic is the first language. As you explore on a minibus, your local guide will share entertaining stories about island life. See cliffside Dun Aengus, the most famous of the Aran Islands' Bronze Age stone forts.

Galway. On a guided walk, take in this spirited city's medieval lanes buzzing with street performers and students.

Westport. Get acquainted with this picturesque Georgian town on a stroll.

Achill Island. Delight in cliff-lined coasts, sheltered beaches and rocky headlands. View the Deserted Village of Slievemore with more than 80 abandoned cottages. Later, learn how to make an Irish coffee.

Connemara. Stand at the base of Croagh Patrick, where St. Patrick is said to have fasted for 40 days in the fifth century, and visit the National Famine Memorial. Next, tour lovely Kylemore Abbey and its gardens.

County Sligo. Appreciate the wild grandeur beloved by poet William Butler Yeats, and visit his grave at Drumcliffe Cemetery. Enjoy lunch on your own in charming Donegal.

Slieve League. Feel like you're standing at the edge of the world at these soaring sea cliffs. Relish Donegal Bay views on a walk.

Donegal Food Tour. In small towns and villages, taste authentic dishes with fresh twists crafted by up-and-coming chefs.

Glenveagh National Park. In this remote, pristine park, tour stately Glenveagh Castle, then enjoy lunch and some free time in the elegant Victorian gardens.

Glebe House & Gallery. Visit a famed artist's former home that boasts eclectic art.

Leo's Tavern. Savor the ambience of this pub owned by a family of musicians that includes Enya, Clannad and Moya Brennan.

Derry-Londonderry & Giant's Causeway. Inside Derry-Londonderry's 17th-century fortified walls, enjoy a fascinating walking tour and lunch. Next, at Giant's Causeway, a UNESCO World Heritage site, marvel at the basalt columns created by giant Finn McCool or an ancient volcanic eruption.
