A World of Discovery

AHI Connects | Rice Noodles. A local family in Siem Reap opens their home to share the secrets of making Cambodian rice noodles, an important culinary tradition.

Bangkok Highlights. Take in daily river life while cruising the Chao Phraya River and Thonburi canals. Disembark and visit the Grand Palace and Emerald Buddha Temple. Next, take a tuk-tuk ride to Wat Pho to see the Reclining Buddha, followed by lunch at the historic Blue Elephant.

Thai Dinner & Cultural Experience. Dine at an elegant riverside restaurant and enjoy a delightful and colorful performance of classical Thai dances.

Ayutthaya. Visit the Bang Pa-In Palace, a summer residence for the kings of Thailand. Continue to ancient Ayutthaya for a glimpse into Thailand's regal past. Once the heart of a powerful kingdom, it is now home to atmospheric brick ruins, lion statues, seated Buddha figures and other artifacts.

Siem Reap. Explore this lively provincial capital by tuk-tuk and see demonstrations by artists at an arts and dance center.

Angkor Wat. Marvel at bas-relief murals and more at this 12th-century crown jewel of the Angkor Archaeological Park, the world's largest religious monument.

Cambodian Circus. Relish an entertaining show that combines acrobatics, storytelling, music and dance.

Angkor's Temples. Take in the impressive Angkor Thom, home to the imposing Bayon temple. Meander in Ta Prohm, a Buddhist monastery swathed by massive tree roots, and admire the ornate Apsara carvings at Thommanon, a notable example of grand Khmer temple architecture.

Highlights of Hanoi. Delve into Vietnam's capital city with your guide. Visit the Ho Chi Minh Mausoleum complex and stroll along leafy streets lined with French colonial-era architecture like the Hanoi Opera House.

Hanoi Hilton. Take a guided tour of Hoa Lò Prison, nicknamed "Hanoi Hilton" by American prisoners during the Vietnam War.

Imperial Citadel of Thang Long. Walk through moss-covered gates and among royal relics in Hanoi's ancient seat of power.

Vietnamese Countryside. Take an electric buggy ride through winding village lanes

and verdant rice fields during a visit to Duong Lam village. Step inside lovely Mia Pagoda filled with hundreds of statues.

Cruising Ha Long Bay. Sail through this splendid bay and admire the breathtaking limestone islands that rise from the emerald waters. Explore a series of caves and grottoes featuring stalactite and stalagmite formations, and anchor overnight in a secluded cove.

Cruising Bai Tu Long Bay. While cruising in this tranquil bay, travel by kayak or rowboat to the Cua Van Floating Culture Center, and visit picturesque Viet Hai Village on Cat Ba Island.

Yen Duc Village. Enjoy lunch and a water puppet show set to folk music that depicts Vietnamese legends and rural stories.
