


- Dürnstein Walking Tour. Admire vineyard landscapes and the iconic blue abbey tower.

- Nuremberg. On a panoramic tour, see the hilltop castle, the Hauptmarkt's famed Gothic fountain and the World War II courthouse.
- History of Nazi Party Exhibit. Uncover the history of the Nazi Party Rallies and Grounds.
- Franconian Countryside. Relish visits to a museum, an abbey and a schnapps distillery.
