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A World of Discovery

Old Havana. Enjoy a guided walk through Habana Vieja to see the four historic main squares and admire the Spanish-colonial architecture. The plazas teem with local life from men playing dominoes to colorful flea markets. Stop to visit Dador, a clothing store founded by three Cuban women, and talk with them about the challenges they overcame to start and own a business. Visit the historic, Hotel Nacional, circa 1930.

Cuban Social Issues & Art. Meet Cuban social psychologist, Norma Guillard to view the documentary, "Maestra," and learn about her important work with the Cuban Literacy Campaign and low-income women. Enjoy a guided tour of the National Museum of Fine Arts led by Wilfredo Benítez Muñoz of the philanthropic Ludwig Foundation.

Vintage Convertible Ride. Feel the wind in your hair on a scenic ride in a privately owned, vintage convertible as glide along the Malecón, Havana's evocative sea drive.

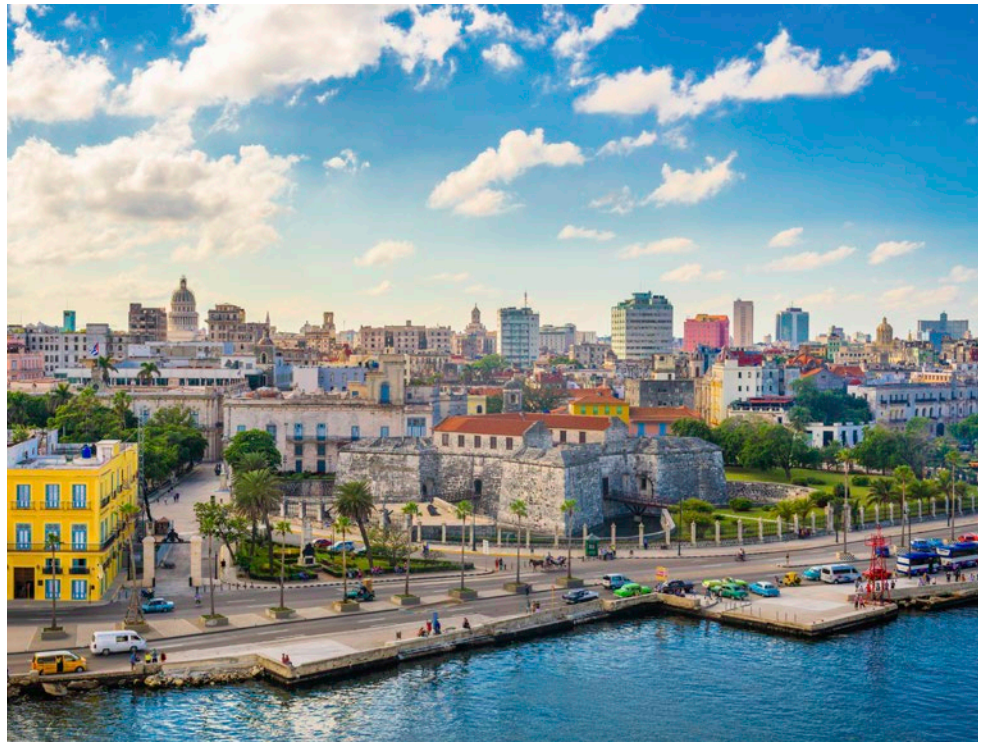
Jewish Culture & Cuban Dance. Visit the Ashkenazi Community Center to learn about Havana's Jewish residents. Stop by local dance company Malpaso to speak to the dancers about their profession and dreams in Cuba, and to see them rehearse. **La Finca Vigia & Ludwig Foundation.** Visit the former home/museum of Ernest Hemingway. Later, gather on the terrace of the Ludwig Foundation to learn how it promotes Cuban artists and culture.

Matanzas. Travel to Cuba's cultural hidden gem rarely visited by tourists. Cross the Puente de Bacunayagua bridge to witness stunning views over a wooded canyon of the lush Yumuri Valley. Tour Matanzas to glimpse life outside the capital. Pass by the Sauto Theatre and the historic French Quarter. Stroll around the city center and Libertad Park and visit a 19th-century French-style pharmacy founded by Ernesto Triolet in 1882. Enjoy a performance by a local choir and chat with choir members.

El Callejon de Hamel. Stroll through this eclectic alleyway buzzing with rumba and vibrant murals, sculptures and street art.

Inside an Art Studio. Visit Casa Fuster, the home and studio of Picasso-inspired Cuban painter and sculptor José Fuster. Learn about his work and enjoy lunch here. Then, interact with the staff and children to learn about Casa de la Cultura's workshops that promote music, dance, theater and more. Then, learn about tango and salsa!

Rural Cuba. Take a scenic drive to visit Las Terrazas, a model socialist community. Walk through town, talk with a school principal and visit an artist's studio, followed by a lunch of locally grown organic vegetables.
