A World of Discovery

Connects | *Meet the People.* Dine with residents and learn about Basque life.

Bordeaux. Get acquainted with this dynamic wine capital on the Garonne River that brims with 18th-century architecture. On a guided walk, see the Grand Théâtre, the regal, 15th-century Porte Cailhau gate and the Place du Parlement. Gaze over the expansive Miroir d'Eau, a reflecting pool in front of the elegant Place de la Bourse.

La Cité du Vin. Experience a fascinating interactive and sensory journey through all facets of wine culture and winemaking at this modern museum, from wine's historical impact and influence on the arts to the complexities of viticulture and terroirs around the world. Afterward, enjoy a glass of wine and scenic views over Bordeaux.

Saint-Émilion. This lovely medieval town surrounded by vineyards lies in the heart of the Bordeaux wine region. After a guided walk along its cobblestone lanes, tour the atmospheric, underground monolithic church of Saint-Émilion, carved into the rocky hillside by monks in the 12th century.

Bordeaux Winery Visit. Taste fine regional French wines at a highly regarded winery.

Arcachon Bay. Known as Le Bassin by locals, this large, shallow body of water is ideal for oyster farming. Take a picturesque jaunt aboard a traditional wooden pinasse boat and see Cap Ferrat and its lighthouse; Dune du Pilat, Europe's largest sand dune; and the old cabane tchanquées, wooden cabins on stilts built by oyster farmers to watch over their farms. Finish with a tasting of fresh oysters by the shore.

Bayonne. On a guided walk in France's Basque capital, visit the splendid Cathedral of Saint Mary of Bayonne, noted for its 13th-century cloisters. During the Middle Ages, it was a stop for pilgrims on their way to Santiago de Compostela in Spain. Relish lunch later at a cozy cider house.

Biarritz. Walk with your guide along the waterfront in this chic French resort town from St. Eugénie Church to Rocher de la Vierge, a rocky outcrop, and see the old fishing port and the medieval watch tower.

San Sebastián. On a guided old town walk, admire the baroque Basílica de Santa María del Coro and other landmarks. Stroll down the boardwalk by stunning La Concha Bay before visiting the San Telmo Museum, focused on the history of Basque culture.

Bilbao & the Guggenheim Museum

Bilbao. After a scenic tour of Bilbao's top sites, view the modern and contemporary art at the Guggenheim, an architectural icon. Relax over lunch afterward in Bilbao.

Laguardia. Soak up the wonderful ambience of the capital of Spain's Rioja Alavesa wine region on a guided walk. See the medieval fortifications, the Romanesque church, the Plaza Mayor and the underground tunnels.

Riojan Barbecue & Winery Visit. Enjoy an al fresco barbecue lunch *(weather permitting)* in Laguardia, then head to an excellent winery to try outstanding regional Spanish wines.
