What to expect: These trips often travel by motor coach, ship, or train. Touring days may include full-day motor coach excursions or extended periods of standing and walking during city tours, museum visits, and/or outdoor activities. Travelers should be able to board transportation, walk over sometimes-uneven terrain, and climb a few flights of stairs, occasionally without handrails or assistance. Elevators are not always available. Outings last two to four hours most days.

Suitable for: Travelers who are able to comfortably walk two to four miles, or 4,600-6,900 steps, each day.

Day 1 | In Transit

Depart your gateway city for Zürich, Switzerland.

Day 2 | Zürich, Switzerland | Basel

Upon arrival, transfer to Basel and embark the MS Amadeus Imperial.

As the ship sails to Breisach, meet your fellow travelers at a Welcome Reception and Dinner.

Day 3 | Breisach, Germany | Freiburg

Freiburg. Stroll in the historic center of this lively university city to admire its 13th-century cathedral, turreted Merchants' Hall and other highlights. Visit the *Christkindlmarkt*, where marzipan and chestnuts are popular treats.

- PYJ | Choose one of these excursions:
- Riquewihr and the Wines of the Alsace.

 Selected as one of "Les Plus Beaux Villages de France," The Most Beautiful Villages of France, this tiny medieval town charms all who visit. Sample some tasty Alsace wines and relish its scenic lanes on a guided walk.
- Colmar Markets. Revel in Alsatian holiday traditions as you explore four markets, each with its own character, in this delightful French town lined with half-timbered houses.

This evening, the ship cruises to Strasbourg, capital of the French region of Alsace.

Day 4 | Strasbourg, France

- PYJ | Choose one of these excursions:
- Strasbourg Panorama. During a panoramic tour, see Strasbourg's German and French

heritage on display in landmarks such as Palais Rohan and St. Thomas Church. Next, walk with your guide in the historic center and behold the impressive Notre Dame Cathedral.

 Culinary Strasbourg. Experience the Alsatian food scene on a guided tour that takes you to the city's winstubs, cozy wine pubs, and other local cafés and shops. On your route, taste delicious cheeses, wines, meats and sweets.

Free Time: Catch a complimentary shuttle from the ship to the city center this afternoon and meander in Strasbourg's luminous *marché de Noël*. First established in the 16th century, it's one of France's oldest holiday markets.


The ship departs Strasbourg late this evening.

Day 5 | Mannheim, Germany | Heidelberg

The ship arrives early in the port of Mannheim. Heidelberg Castle and Town. Step inside Heidelberg Castle overlooking the Neckar Valley, and see the immense wine barrel built in 1591, which once contained 34,342 gallons of wine! Then, follow your guide on a pleasant walk in the old town and along the banks of the Neckar River. Relax over lunch at a German restaurant, where you'll feel the comfortable, friendly ambience known as gemütlichkeit.

Free Time: Spend some time on your own in Heidelberg's historic center.

The Amilian School Amusical Trio. Settle in for an exclusive performance by a talented trio in Heidelberg who will entertain you with holiday songs, arias and contemporary pieces.



Day 6 | Rüdesheim | Rhine Gorge

PYJ | Choose one of these excursions:

- Rüdesheim Tour. Board a tram that takes you down charming Drosselgasse and stop at the "Christmas Market of the Nations" with holiday items from around the world. At a captivating museum, be amazed by the incredible ingenuity and melodies of music boxes, player pianos and other restored mechanical musical instruments.
- Rhine Wine Tasting. Visit the tranquil Abbey of St. Hildegard and learn about the multitalented St. Hildegard of Bingen, a prominent woman in the medieval church. Later, sample the region's fine wines in the old cellar of a family-run winery.

Enrichment: German Holiday Traditions. From Advent wreaths to Christmas baking, learn about cherished family customs at home. On the way to Cologne this afternoon, sail through a stunning section of the river known as the Rhine Gorge. This picturesque, gently curving 40-mile stretch was designated

a UNESCO World Heritage site for its historical, cultural and geological significance. Before dinner tonight, gather for a Glühwein party with your fellow cruisers. If you haven't already tried it at one of the holiday markets, indulge in this warm concoction of cinnamon, cloves, citrus and wine, a wintertime classic!

Day 7 | Cologne

The ship docks in Cologne early this morning. Cologne Walking Tour. Kölner Dom, the city's majestic cathedral, is northern Europe's largest Gothic church and a UNESCO World Heritage site. Topped by two filigreed spires, it was built over a period of more than 630 years. See the highlights within the old town on a guided walk. Then, take in the cathedral's awe-inspiring façade before going inside to admire the details of the splendid interior.

Free Time: This afternoon, complimentary shuttles will run between the ship and the city center. Shop for handcrafted mementos at the Christmas market outside the cathedral. The ship heads toward Düsseldorf tonight.

Kougelhopf, a famous Alsatian specialty, is a yeasted sweet cake filled with raisins and almonds. The decorative molds used to bake them are often handed down within families.





Day 8 | Düsseldorf

PYJ | Choose one of these excursions:

- Düsseldorf Tour. Admire this dynamic city's modern architecture, including the bustling Medienhafen riverfront area, on a scenic tour. Later, take a guided walk in the old town, which boasts a half-mile stretch of more than 250 bars, breweries and cafés. Along your route, try some Altbier, the local dark beer.
- Aachen, City of Emperor Charlemagne.

 Aachen was the imperial capital and favorite royal residence of Charlemagne (747–814), who also enjoyed its therapeutic hot springs. Visit breathtaking Aachen Cathedral, notable for Charlemagne's richly decorated imperial chapel and his original throne. Next, walk in the historic center and spa area, then finish at the city's cheery Christmas market.

Free Time: Explore Düsseldorf's six wonderful *Christkindlmarkts* featuring themes such as handicrafts, angels and fairy tales.

Celebrate your yuletide cruise with your fellow travelers at a Farewell Reception and Dinner.

Day 9 | In Transit

After breakfast, transfer \Im to the airport for the return flight \Im to your gateway city.




