 AHI Connects | Catalan Cooking. Learn about the history and traditions of Catalan gastronomy during an interactive cooking demonstration and authentic lunch.

Gothic Quarter. Begin a guided walk at the Gothic, Barcelona Cathedral, near the surviving Roman walls that once defined the perimeter. Continue to Catalan's historic powerhouse, Plaça del Rei, to witness where medieval Barcelona flourished at the center of the old city. Stroll the labyrinth of winding, cobblestone streets to soak up the medieval architecture and ambience.

Montjuïc & Barcelona's Waterfront. Take a drive up to Montjuïc hill to see a site of the 1992 Summer Olympics. Travel down to the waterfront, passing the Christopher Columbus monument, the city symbol; the World Trade Center, shaped like a ship; the medieval, royal Drassanes shipyards; and the Marina Port Vell's yachts and boardwalk. Art Nouveau Masterpieces. Marvel at the architectural dream that is Barcelona. Stroll past brightly colored buildings designed by Spanish modernist architects. Visit Antoni Gaudí's most famous work, La Sagrada Familía - the still unfinished, surprising and often controversial basilica is a symbol of Barcelona. Then, visit the extraordinary complex of the former Hospital Sant Pau. Designed by Lluís Domènech i Montaner, Spanish architect, the campus is regarded for its singular beauty and design sensitivity.

Picasso Museum. On a guided visit, learn about the relationship between Barcelona and Picasso at the eponymous museum, holding more than 4,200 works of his art.

El Born Walking Tour. Experience this emblematic neighborhood and cultural hub, once home to medieval tournaments and fiestas. Stroll past authentic boutiques and lively cafés to bourgeois Calle de Montcada, a noble street where 12th-century mansions now house art museums and galleries. Then see the 14th-century, Santa Maria del Mar, designed in true, Catalan Gothic style.

Barcelona Tapas. After your El Born walk, join a guide for a jaunt to three tapas bars for a tasty lunch and Spanish wine tasting. Palau de la Música Catalana. Visit one of the world's most beautiful treasures of Catalan Modernism. Be awed by the sheer grandeur within – the stunning and soaring, ornate ceilings and columns, massive organ and spectacular skylight portraying the sun.

Magical Park Güell. Be awed by the iconic, playful Gaudí masterpiece, an enormous garden with distinct Catalan architectural elements, including colorful mosaics and imaginative structures, like the Serpentine Bench and "dragon" statue and fountain.
