Day 1 | In Transit

Depart for Zagreb, Croatia. 🚗

Day 2 | Zagreb, Croatia

Upon arrival, transfer 🔄 and check in to your hotel. Gather tonight for a convivial Welcome Reception and Dinner.

Day 3 | Zagreb

Enrichment: Contemporary Croatia.

Zagreb Panoramic Tour. Zagreb weaves European elegance with a vivacious Balkan spirit. After a panoramic tour of the lower town, drive to Mirogoj Cemetery, designed by architect Hermann Bollé. Tour the cemetery, then return to Zagreb's beautifully preserved upper town, home to more treasures by Bollé, including the fantastic St. Mark's Church.

Day 4 | Zagreb

Free Time: Make your own discoveries in Zagreb today or join our elective excursion.

🗺️ **Elective | Croatian Countryside.** Visit the Antun Augustincic Museum and Gallery in Klanjec before continuing to Kumrovec.

The village features an open-air museum with houses from the end of the 19th century and the beginning of the 20th century. Slow down and enjoy lunch during your outing.

Day 5 | Zagreb | Plitvice Lakes National Park | Opatija

After breakfast, depart Zagreb for Opatija. En route, visit Plitvice Lakes National Park.

Plitvice Lakes National Park. This park features 16 crystal-clear terraced lakes linked by a series of waterfalls. Wander planked

walkways and trails amid a fragrant forest.

The area is also home to nearly 160 species of birds and numerous plant species.

Continue to Opatija and board your ship. Later, enjoy a Welcome Reception and Dinner.

Day 6 | Krk Island | Rab Island

Begin cruising along the Dalmatian Coast, a landscape of limestone cliffs. While sailing to Krk and Rab islands, soak up the nautical paradise, breathe in the salty air and revel in the beauty of far-off islands perched on the horizon.

Krk and Rab Islands. Visit Krk Island, which lies in the middle of Kvarner Bay. Enjoy lunch on board while docked in this charming port. Next, uncover the marvels of Rab Island, from medieval walls to ancient stone lanes and bell towers. Spy local artists and taste Rapska torta, or Rab cake. Legend claims that the cake was first served in 1177 to Pope Alexander III.

Day 7 | Zadar

Enjoy cruising to the pretty town of Zadar. If

luck is on your side, you may see dolphins!
Zadar. This university town is home to an impressive Roman Forum and the Church of St. Donatus. Walk along the waterfront promenade to see modern attractions, including the sea organ. Listen to the melody of this musical art installation, which is fueled by the ebb and flow of the currents. During your outing, sample some unique Maraschino cherry liquor and other locally made sweets. The first recipes of the Maraschino liquor emerged from Zadar during the 16th century.

Day 8 | Šibenik

Sail to Šibenik this morning. Šibenik is a proud city that welcomes visitors with lovely alleys, squares and striking buildings.

- **Cultural Šibenik.** Visit the UNESCO-listed Cathedral of St. James, one of Europe's most significant monumental churches. Enjoy a wine, cheese and prosciutto tasting!

- **Krka National Park.** Delight in the waterfalls, walking paths and more of this top-rated park. The park features seven waterfalls. (Active)

Day 9 | Trogir | Split

Pull up anchor and cruise to Trogir.

Trogir. Fall under the spell of Trogir, a well-preserved Romanesque-Gothic town. See the Cathedral of St. Lawrence, the intricate Cipiko Palace and the Fortress Kamerlengo, built in the 15th century. Plus, admire the Benedictine Monastery, founded by St. Ivan of Trogir.

Split. Behold Split's many riches, including a walk through the courtyards and chambers of Diocletian's Palace. See the Cathedral of Saint Domnius, the Golden Gate and the Peristyle

Day 10 | Hvar Island | Korčula

Hvar Island. Uncover the sights of sunny Hvar, including its Renaissance cathedral, a community theater and a convent dedicated to
