A World of Discovery

AHI Connects | Italian Coffee & Café Culture. At one of the city's oldest cafés, delve into the social rituals behind Italy's passion for coffee and learn how favorite choices are prepared and served.

Florence Walk. Explore the glorious Cradle of the Renaissance. Admire the Cathedral of Santa Maria del Fiore and take in the intricate façade, distinctive dome and striking bell tower designed by Giotto. View the bronze doors of the Baptistery that Michelangelo called the Gates of Paradise. Cross the Arno River on the Ponte Vecchio, and linger in the Piazza della Signoria.

Towns of Chianti. Travel the quiet back roads of Chianti, a dreamy vision of hill towns, woodlands and vineyards. Explore San Gimignano, a hill town with 14 medieval tower houses. In Castellina in Chianti, a local chef will show you how to cook like Tuscans do. Then, enjoy the mouthwatering results for lunch! Later, visit Castello di Monsanto, built in 1750, and enjoy a tasting of Chianti's famous wines.

Accademia Visit. Tour this renowned museum to see Michelangelo's statue of David, paintings and sculptures by legendary artists and an exquisite collection of rare musical instruments, including pieces crafted by Antonio Stradivari and Bartolomeo Cristofori.

Uffizi Gallery. Follow the evolution of Italian art from the 13th century through the 16th century in the Uffizi's grand halls, which contain some of the world's most acclaimed masterpieces.

Colle di Val d'Elsa & Siena. Stroll along Colle's narrow lanes and delight in its noble houses and medieval tower houses. In Siena, step into the shell-shaped Piazza del Campo and learn about its importance to the city. Pause by the Gaia Fountain to see its bas-relief sculptures. *(Active)*
