

### Day 1 | In Transit

Depart your gateway city for Cape Town, South Africa. 🌍

### Day 2 | Cape Town, South Africa

Upon arrival in Cape Town, transfer ➡ to the Mount Nelson Hotel.

Later, join us for a Welcome Reception.

### Day 3 | Cape Town | Cape Point

**Cape Peninsula.** Delight in scenic panoramas along Marine Drive as you pass Table Mountain and the Twelve Apostles. Continue along the coast to the Cape of Good Hope, at Africa's southwestern tip. Take a funicular ride at Cape Point to the lighthouse for breathtaking views, then visit Boulders Beach to observe adorable African penguins in their colony.

### Day 4 | Robben Island | Cape Town

**Cape Town.** Cruise by ferry to Robben Island and tour the prison where Nelson Mandela was incarcerated. Your guide, a former prisoner of Robben Island, offers first-hand insight. Discover the many highlights of South Africa's Mother City, with free time at Victoria & Alfred Waterfront, before ascending Table Mountain (weather permitting) to soak in incredible views.

### Day 5 | Hoedspruit | Kapama Private Game Reserve

Following breakfast, fly to Hoedspruit. Upon arrival, transfer to the Kapama River Lodge.

**Safari:** Get the lay of the African bushveld during your first game drive in Kapama Private

Game Reserve. Meet your ranger and tracker, who will accompany you on each game drive. Begin your quest to spy the marvelous Big Five.

### Day 6 | Kapama Private Game Reserve

Each morning on safari starts with a wake-up call from your ranger. Meet on the deck for coffee before climbing into your vehicle.

**Safari:** It may seem quiet as the sun starts its journey across the sky, but there is plenty of animal activity. Many animals are just waking up and preparing to search for breakfast! Others are winding down after a night on the prowl and looking for a place to sleep during the day.

**Free Time:** Spend the rest of the morning at your leisure. Visit the spa or relax with a book.

**Enrichment: The Animals of Kapama.**

Enjoy tea before the afternoon drive.

**Safari:** Get a different perspective as you see diurnal animals settling down for the evening and nocturnal animals beginning theirs.

As the sun sets, celebrate your day with a round of sundowners, drinks enjoyed at sunset.

### Day 7 | **Kapama Private Game Reserve**

**Safari:** Each game drive offers a unique experience forged by the time of day, weather and locale. Your tracker and ranger are experts at locating animals. They know the thickets where giraffes nibble at the treetops, the open veld where zebra graze and much more.

**Free Time:** Enjoy time at leisure.

**Safari:** Observe popular watering holes where four-legged and feathered residents gather.

### Day 8 | **Hoedspruit | Johannesburg**

Transfer to Hoedspruit and fly to Johannesburg.

**AHI Connects | Soweto.** Visit Soweto and see the homes of Nelson Mandela and Archbishop Desmond Tutu. In Kliptown, learn about a youth program offering tutoring alongside sports and arts. Meet some of the resident youth and enjoy a performance. Check in to 54 on Bath in Johannesburg.

### Day 9 | **Pretoria | Embark Rovos Rail | Zimbabwe**

This morning, depart for the train station in Pretoria to board the luxurious Rovos Rail.



Travel north through Bela-Bela and Modimolle to Musina (formerly Messina) for the Beitbridge border crossing into Zimbabwe.

### Day 10 | **Zimbabwe**

Travel through Rutenga and Somabhula on your way to Bulawayo. Take in scenes of daily life as you continue through the city. Gather for afternoon tea on your journey to Mpopoma, where the train overnights.

### Day 11 | **Hwange National Park**

Depart Mpopoma and journey along one of the world's longest stretches of straight track.

**Safari:** After disembarking in Kennedy Siding, go on a game drive at The Hide, a private concession in Hwange National Park. This park, known for its natural beauty, is home to more than 100 mammal and 400 bird species. Visit one of the most popular watering holes to see some of the residents!

### Day 12 | **Disembark Rovos Rail | Victoria Falls**

Disembark the train in Victoria Falls and transfer to the Victoria Falls Hotel.


