



Day 1 | In-transit

Depart for Lisbon, Portugal.

Day 2 | Lisbon, Portugal

Arrive in Lisbon, transfer **3** and check in to the Dom Pedro Lisboa hotel.

This evening, meet your fellow travelers at a Welcome Reception, with canapés.

Day 3 | Lisbon

Lisbon City Tour. Discover vibrant Lisbon today on a half-day panoramic tour. See the majestic 16th-century Tower of Belém and the nautical Monument to the Discoveries. Visit Jerónimos Monastery, a stunning example of Manueline architecture and lasting tribute to Portugal's Golden Age. Make a photo stop at the elegant Praça do Comércio square, with stunning waterfront views of the Tagus River.

Free Time: Enjoy the rest of the day at leisure.

Day 4 | Terceira Island, Azores | Angra do Heroísmo

After breakfast, fly to Terceira. Arrive, transfer and check in to the Azoris Angra Garden.

Enrichment: History of the Azores.

Angra do Heroísmo. Take a guided walk of this city founded in 1478. Visit the neo-classical, 19th-century City Hall in the Praça Velha square to learn about the city's rich civic heritage.

Savor flavorful local cuisine at lunch together.

AHI Connects | Experiential Azorean

Dinner. Drive to Quinta do Martelo, an authentic Azorean farmstead to stop at the local market, discover the island's culinary heritage and savor a delicious dinner in the atmospheric farmhouse.

Day 5 | Terceira

Island Tour. Capture the essence of Terceira on a panoramic tour. Stop at viewpoints for stunning island views and in São Sebastião to see its 15th-century church. Break for lunch together and then visit Algar do Carvão to tour the deep volcanic cave and lava tube. (Active) Conclude the day in charming Biscoitos, known for its natural lava rock swimming pools. Opt to take a dip or stroll through the town at leisure.

Day 6 | Faial Island | Horta

Faial Tour. After you land, begin an island tour. Visit the Capelinhos Volcano & Interpretation Center, where the submarine eruption of 1957 vastly altered the island's landscape. Stop for lunch and then visit the Caldeira nature reserve to gaze in awe at its massive crater. Continue toward Horta, pausing to appreciate the scenic views of Horta Bay and Pico Mountain.

After breakfast, take a short flight to Faial.

Arrive and check in to the Azoris Faial Garden.

Free Time: The rest of the day is at your leisure.





Day 7 | Pico Island | Fail

Vineyards of Pico. Take an early morning ferry ride over to Pico and visit the vineyards in Criação Velha, where grapevines grow from black basalt stone walls, a stunning visual contrast to the deep-blue ocean. Learn about the viticulture techniques used for over 500 years and Pico's mineral-rich Verdelho wine. Relish an Azorean lunch at a local winery.


Lajes & Whaling History. Tour the Whaler's Museum in Lajes, a major whaling hub from the 18th century until 1984. Delve into the Azores' complex whaling history via exhibits of whaling boats, harpoons, historical documents and photos, illustrating the whalers' daily lives. Take the ferry back to Faial and your hotel.

Day 8 | Faial | São Miguel Island | Ponta Delgada

Enrichment: Contemporary Azores.

After the lecture, fly to Ponta Delgada, São Miguel Island. Arrive, have lunch and set out on your guided city walking tour.

Ponta Delgada & Carlos Machado Museum. Take a guided stroll of this capital city to see the grand city gates, constructed of black basalt with whitewashed accents; picturesque squares with colorful Portuguese pavement





designs and the 17th-century City Hall. Then, visit the Carlos Machado Museum to discover the archipelago's natural and cultural heritage. Check in to the Octant Ponta Delgada hotel.

Day 9 | São Miguel

Furnas Crater. Drive to the village of Furnas to stand in awe at the Lagoa das Furnas volcanic crater lake, surrounded by misty green hills and dotted with steaming fumaroles, bubbling mud pools and sulfur vents. Watch as a traditional stew is buried in the ground to be cooked by volcanic heat. Later, savor the Cozido das Furnas stew for lunch at a nearby restaurant.


Terra Nostra Park. After lunch, stroll through these beautiful, diverse botanical gardens and marvel at the orange-hued hot-thermal pool.

Gorreana Tea Factory. Visit Europe's oldest tea plantation still in operation to stroll the tea fields and tour the production factory.

Day 10 | São Miguel

Whale Watching. Embark on a thrilling boat expedition to look for sightings of majestic,





graceful whales and playful dolphins in one of the world's best and largest whale sanctuaries.

Lagoa do Fogo. Visit this nature park to stand on the crater's rim and behold the serene lake and stunning scenery. Be awed by Caldeira Velha natural hot springs, enveloped by giant ferns, and see its iconic warm iron waterfall.

Ribeira Grande. Visit this town steeped in Portuguese character. Stroll along azulejo-tiled streets to see the baroque-style Town Hall and the graceful, arched Ribeira Grande Bridge.

Day 11 | São Miguel

Jeep Excursion. Venture to a remote volcanic crater region to admire the beautiful, serene Canário lake. Stop at a viewpoint to gaze at stunning panoramic views, the iconic Sete Cidades blue and green twin lakes, a vast caldera framed by lush, mountainous forests.

Farewell Reception, Dinner & Folklore Performance. Enjoy this evening's reception, dinner and special folklore Performance.

Day 12 | In Transit

After breakfast, check out of the hotel and transfer **3** to the Ponta Delgada Airport for your return flights **4** home.
