

Kotor's Old Town

Day 1 | In Transit

Depart gateway city for Dubrovnik, Croatia.

Day 2 | Dubrovnik, Croatia | Tivat, Montenegro

Upon arrival in Dubrovnik, transfer **2** to Tivat, Montenegro, and check in to your hotel. Gather for a Welcome Reception and Dinner.

Day 3 | Centinje

Enrichment: History of Montenegro.

Cetinje – The Old Capital. Known as the country's capital between 1878 and 1946, Cetinje is a living time capsule with impressive architecture, galleries, art academies and museums that reveal cultural and historical insights into Montenegro. Take a guided tour of the National Museum of Montenegro, housed throughout five historic buildings. Sit down to a lunch of regional cuisine at a country-style restaurant.

Day 4 | Bay of Kotor | Perast | Kotor

Bay of Kotor. This awe-inspiring scene was not carved by glaciers. Instead, the strikingly beautiful bay is a *ria*, or a submerged river valley that was created by rising sea levels. Revel in jaw-dropping hills, plummeting cliffs and indigo waters during a private cruise to Our Lady of the Rocks, a man-made island. Along the way, learn about the island's legend and tour its baroque-style church.

Continue to medieval Perast, a charming lakefront town with a storied seafaring history. The jumble of alleys showcases 16 churches as well as defensive towers and monuments. In nearby Kotor, admire the Old Town encircled by miles of fortifications. Take time to linger along cobbled lanes that give way to shaded squares, historic churches and restaurants.

Day 5 | Lake Skadar | Tuzi

Lake Skadar. Travel through a lush mountain landscape to the largest freshwater lake in the Balkans, perched on the Montenegrin and Albanian border. The lake and its surrounds are a pristine wonderland peppered with sleepy villages and the remains of ancient monasteries, monuments and churches. During a boat tour, admire the lake's flora and fauna, glide through lily pads and learn about the area's ecosystem and endemic species, including otters, dragonflies and over 270 species of birds.

Enjoy a group lunch during your outing.

AHI Connects | *Montenegrin Winery.* Journey to the small town of Tuzi to visit a vineyard owned by Plantaže, one of Eastern Europe's biggest producers of wine and grape

brandy. Tour the company's Šipčanik wine cellar, located in a former underground Yugoslav-era aircraft hangar. Learn about the region's unique microclimates and grape varietals and sample Montenegrin wines.

Enrichment: Yugoslavia & Montenegro.

Day 6 | Budva | Kotor

Enrichment: Independent Montenegro. Insight into Montenegro's Monasteries

& Budva. Over 50 monasteries are sprinkled throughout Montenegro, each with significant historical and cultural treasures. Visit two monasteries today — the medieval Serbian Orthodox Reževići Monastery and the thousand-year-old Praskvica Monastery. Located in an olive grove, the UNESCO-protected Monastery of Reževići overlooks the sea and is comprised of two churches.

Continue to Budva, a coastal town enclosed within medieval citadel walls. During a guided walk, witness the narrow streets lined with

charming shops, bars, churches and eateries. Take note of the 14th-century Saint Sava Church and the pink-and-white stone Church of the Holy Trinity. These handsome churches tell stories of the different peoples that have passed through Budva.

Kotor by Night. After sunset, the streetlights cast a soft, romantic glow on Kotor's meandering lanes and honey-hued buildings. Enjoy the tranquil ambience at your own pace and find a special spot for dinner.

Day 7 | Tivat | Dubrovnik, Croatia

After breakfast, drive to Dubrovnik, Croatia, and check in to your hotel.

Darling Dubrovnik. Discover the highlights of Dubrovnik during a walking tour. Admire the 14th-century Franciscan Monastery's Romanesque cloister and visit its small

apothecary, the oldest working pharmacy in Europe. Pass by the medieval Sponza Palace and see the loggia and ornamentation of the Rector's Palace. Step into the baroque cathedral, largely destroyed during a 17th-century earthquake. The cathedral was rebuilt in 1713 by architect Ilija Katičić.

Day 8 | Dubrovnik

Free Time: Spend time pursuing your own interests or join our elective activity.

Elective | Idyllic Pelješac Peninsula.

Beloved for its stunning beauty, the rugged Pelješac Peninsula is abundant with fjords, quiet bays and vineyards. Today, visit some of the world's oldest salt harvesting sites and see the Great Wall of Ston, which links Ston to Mali Ston. Enjoy a winery visit and cruise to the fishing village of Mali Ston. At an oyster farm, taste delicious bivalves just plucked from the sea and sip a glass of wine.

Tonight, share in a festive Farewell Reception and Dinner to commemorate your journey.

Day 9 | In Transit

After breakfast, transfer **O** to the Dubrovnik airport for the return flight **O** to your gateway city.

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
