### Day 1| In Transit

Depart your gateway city for Madrid, Spain.

### Day 2 | Madrid, Spain

Arrive and transfer **>** to the Hotel Wellington & Spa Madrid.

### Enrichment: Contemporary Spain.

This evening, enjoy a Welcome Reception at the hotel followed by dinner at a local restaurant.

### Day 3 | Madrid

Madrid's Art & Architecture. Set out on a panoramic tour of Madrid with a stop at the Plaza Mayor, the esplanade in the city center considered a symbol of Madrid. Then, relish a private visit to the acclaimed Prado Museum, holding pieces by prominent artists, including Velázquez, El Greco, Goya and Bosch.

Savor a group lunch at a local restaurant.

**Palacio Royal.** After lunch, visit the grand Royal Palace, the official residence of the Spanish royal family in Madrid and the location for state ceremonies and important events. Completed in 1764, the Baroque-style palace is one of the largest in Europe, with more than 3,400 rooms.

### Day 4 | Toledo | Madrid

**Toledo**. Tour this artistically beautiful city. See the magnificent Puerta de Bisagra and the Mudéjar style of the Synagogue of Santa María la Blanca. Visit the Cathedral of Toledo, known for its Spanish Gothic architectural grandeur, and be awed by El Greco's masterpiece, "The Burial of the Count of Orgaz," at the Church of Santo Tome. Enjoy lunch at a local restaurant.

### Day 5 | Madrid

**Free Time:** Relish a full day to explore Madrid at leisure. Consider day trips to Segovia or Avila, or visit other renowned art museums in Madrid.

### Day 6 | Madrid | Barcelona

After an early breakfast, transfer **O** to the station to board your direct train to Barcelona. Arrive and enjoy some free time and lunch on your own before joining the walking tour.

**Barcelona's Gothic Quarter.** Take a guided tour of the labyrinth of narrow streets in the Barri Gòtic, old city, where medieval Barcelona flourished. Stroll Carrer del Bisbe, where the Neo-Gothic Bishop's Bridge, Ponte del Bisbe, connects government buildings. Also, see the Plaça de Sant Jaume, the current seat of local and regional government; the Plaça del Rei, the historic powerhouse of medieval Catalonia; the 13th-century Cathedral of Barcelona; and remnants of the city's Roman walls.

Check in to the Renaissance Barcelona Hotel and join your group later for dinner in the hotel.

### Day 7 | Barcelona

# **Enrichment:** Modernism & the Architecture of Gaudí.

### Gaudí's Barcelona & Catalan Modernism.

Today, experience the surreal works of Antoni Gaudí. The Spanish architect was a leading exponent of Europe's art nouveau movement, characterized by intense ornamentation and organic lines. On a guided walk, visit Gaudí's playful Parc Güell to marvel at the architectural elements of colorful mosaics, organic shapes and imaginative structures – fanciful serpentine benches and a dragon stairway and fountain. Savor lunch at Can Cortada, an atmospheric Catalan farmhouse restaurant.

### Hospital de Sant Pau & La Sagrada Familía.

After lunch, visit the extraordinary art nouveau campus of the former Hospital de Sant Pau, built between 1901 and 1930 and regarded for its singular beauty and sensitivity to design.

Finish the day with a walk along the Avinguda Gaudí, one of the city's most historic avenues. Then, visit La Sagrada Familía, Gaudí's most famous and sometimes controversial work. Gaudí took over as chief architect in 1883, designing the colossal basilica using Gothic and art nouveau forms. Still unfinished, it has become the beloved symbol of Barcelona.

### Day 8 | Barcelona


### PYJ | Choose one of these excursions:

- Casa Amatilier. Walk the Passeig de Gràcia and take in prime examples of the Modernist movement in Barcelona before visiting Casa Amatller House Museum to discover the elements of Catalan Modernist architecture.
- *Barcelona's Jewish History.* Explore the history of the Catalan Jews with a walk through Barcelona's old Jewish Quarter. Visit Casa Adret, an enchanting13th-century palace-house that is now a Jewish cultural and research center called Mozaika's Hub.

### Day 9 | In Transit

# **Enrichment:** *The History of Catalonia* & Barcelona.

(Felective | Montserrat & Penedès Wine Region. Travel to the monastery at Montserrat to admire the stunning views from atop the mountainside. Visit the Basilica, which houses the serene image of the Virgin of Montserrat, the patron saint of Catalonia. Continue to Penedès, Catalonia's premier wine producing region known for its reds, whites and famous Cava sparkling wine. Indulge in lunch and a wine tasting before returning to Barcelona.

**Free Time:** Or, opt out of the Elective Activity and enjoy the full day at leisure in Barcelona. Share highlights of your trip during the Farewell Reception and Dinner this evening.

### Day 10 | In Transit

After breakfast, transfer **O** to the Barcelona airport for the return flight **O** to your gateway city.




