A World of Discovery

Egyptian Museum. Visit this acclaimed, historic landmark that opened in 1902, which contains priceless collections of Egyptian antiquities, including the complete burials of Yuya, Thuya and Psusennes I as well as the fabulous treasures of Tanis.

Sakkara. In this ancient necropolis, visit the Mastaba of Mereruka, the Pyramid Tomb of King Teti and the Step Pyramid of Djoser.

The Pyramids of Giza. Take in the majestic Great Pyramid constructed with roughly 2.3 million massive blocks of stone, and get a close-up look at the enigmatic Sphinx.

Al-Muizz Street & Islamic Cairo. Stroll with your guide along lively Al-Muizz, where Cairo's many grand mosques are located. Tour the 13th-century Qalawun complex, featuring a madrasa, mausoleum and historic hospital, and visit Bayt Al-Suhaymi, a beautiful, 17th-century house. Afterward, explore the colorful Khan el Khalili bazaar.

Coptic Cairo. Visit the Hanging Church, one of the oldest churches in Egypt, built on the gate of a Roman fortress, and the Church of St. Sergius, believed to be built over a cave where Mary, Joseph and Jesus once rested after fleeing to Egypt.

Luxor Museum. View splendid artifacts that embody the glory of ancient Thebes.

Temple of Luxor. Sail on a felucca boat along the Nile to this expansive complex. Construction began during the reign of Amenhotep III, and subsequent rulers, including Tutankhamen, Ramses II and Alexander the Great, added to it.

Luxor's West Bank - The Valleys of the Kings & Queens. Visit this legendary area where New Kingdom pharaohs and their families awaited immortality. Go inside the tombs of Nefertari and Tutankhamen, and explore the Temple of Hatshepsut. After a stop at an alabaster workshop, head to the tomb of Amun-her-Khepeshef and then see the Colossi of Memnon.

The Epigraphic Survey of the Oriental Institute, University of Chicago (Chicago House). During an exclusive visit, learn how the Institute preserves ancient sites through unique documentation and restoration work.

Temple of Karnak. Visit the burial place of the 18th-dynasty royal family, notable for its great hypostyle hall of 134 gigantic columns.

Temple of Horus at Edfu. See reliefs about ancient religious rituals and political life.

Temple of Sobek & Haroeris. Explore this unusual double temple dedicated to the gods of the sky and fertility.

Abu Simbel. Fly to this top-rated site to see the colossal Great Temple of Ramses II and the well-preserved Temple of Hathor.

Temple of Philae & Aswan High Dam. Travel to the island temple complex of Philae for a guided tour. Visit the Papyrus Institute and see the High Dam, which was built in the 1960s to control the Nile's annual flooding.

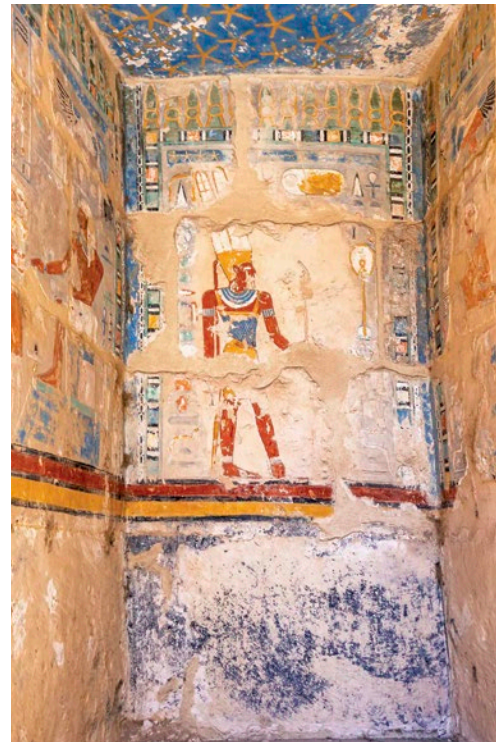
