A World of Discovery

AHI Connects | Family Neuhold

Farm. Learn the secrets behind growing, harvesting and producing the famed Styrian pumpkin seed oil at this family farm. Taste a variety of oils with accompanying snacks.

Graz. Take a guided walking tour past baroque and medieval architecture in the old town on your way to the top of tree-clad Schlossberg, once home to a 10th century fortress that affords a bird's-eye view of the historic center. See the 13th-century, 90-foot Uhrturm clock tower before strolling back through the Hauptplatz main square to see the city's first opera house and visit the 15th-century Graz Cathedral.

Eastern Styria. Venture to the lush farmland region, known for its chocolate, ham and Styrian wine. Take a guided tour of the medieval Riegersburg Castle, visit the family-owned Vulcano Farm and enjoy a typical *jausenteller* lunch. Visit a premier Austrian chocolatier for a tour and tasting.

Western Styria. Revel in a guided excursion through the countryside to see the eclectic St. Barbara Church in Bärbach, followed by a visit to see the world-famous Lipizzaner stallions and learn about their centuries-old horse breeding methods. Savor a wine tasting lunch at a rustic, inn-like *buschenschank*.

Hallstatt and the Salzkammergut. Visit the picturesque alpine village of Hallstatt. Take a guided walk along cobblestone streets through the quaint market square to admire the 16th-century architecture. Cruise on Lake Hallstatt amid the breathtaking and dramatic Austrian Alps.

Salzburg. On a guided walking tour, admire this baroque architecture in the historic district and see the landmarks of Mozart's life. Take a funicular up to Festungsberg mountaintop to visit the Hohensalzburg Fortress, with a spectacular view of the historic city center.

Mozart Performance and Dinner. Enjoy duets from "Figaro," "The Magic Flute" and "Don Giovanni" in a memorable Mozart concert and authentic Austrian dinner.

"The Sound of Music" Tour. Celebrate the 60th anniversary of the beloved movie filmed around Salzburg. Visit iconic sites such as the famous Gazebo scene location.

Berchtesgaden and the Bavarian Alps. Cross the border into Germany today to the Bavarian Alps. Stop at the Berchtesgaden Salt Mine for a guided tour 2,132 feet deep in this 500-year-old mine. Travel up to Mount Kehlstein for a visit to Hitler's Eagle's Nest, with panoramic views overlooking Germany and Austria, followed by a Bavarian lunch in an authentic beer garden.
