Seight-night Italian adventure! Enjoy stays in Parma and Cortona and uncover the spirit, culture and heritage of Italy's delightful Emilia-Romagna and Tuscany regions. From Bologna's storied *porticoes* to Parma's lauded cathedral, charming medieval villages to beautiful country farms, these destinations will seduce all your senses. Along the way, savor culinary favorites, including balsamic vinegar, parmesan cheese and pasta. Plus, sip and swirl locally made wines at a Tuscan winery and hone your cooking skills while learning to make typical regional dishes.

Day-by-Day Itinerary

Day 1 | In Transit

Depart for Milan, Italy.

Day 2 | Milan, Italy | Parma

Arrive in Milan, transfer to Parma and check in to the Sina Maria Luigia hotel.

Later tonight, gather with your fellow travelers for a Welcome Reception and Dinner.

Day 3 | Parma

Parma Walking Tour. The day begins with a discovery of wonderful Parma! Perhaps most famous for its delicious ham and cheese, Parma is also packed with regal palaces, gardens and storied landmarks. During a walking tour, see the Parma Cathedral and the Teatro Regio di Parma, the performance home of composer Giuseppe Verdi. Also pass by the Palazzo della Pilotta and through the Piazza Garibaldi.

Free Time: Make your own plans in Parma. Stroll through Parco Ducale or sip wine at an outdoor café.

Day 4 | Parma | Vigoleno | Castell'Arquato

Cheese Farm, Vigoleno & Castell'Arquato. Head out to the country to visit a cheese farm. During an intimate tour, learn how expert cheese makers turn milk, salt and rennet into sensational parmesan cheese. After lunch, step back in time along the medieval streets of Vigoleno. Lauded as one of Italy's most compelling villages, Vigoleno is home to a well-preserved fortified castle and the Romanesque Church of San Giorgio. Continue to pretty Castell'Arquato and see the town's highlights on a walking tour.

Day 5 | Parma | Modena

PYJ | Choose one of the following excursions:

- Ferrari Museum in Maranello. Venture to Maranello to encounter the beloved Italian sports car brand. Take a guided panoramic tour of the Ferrari estate and view the outside of the Ferrari workshops and plants. Learn about the history of the car at the Ferrari museum.
- Reggio Emilia Walking Tour. Get to know this lovely, laid-back city on a walking tour. Pass by the imposing Santa Maria cathedral, the old Jewish Ghetto, the Basilica di San Prospero and the baroque Basilica della Ghiara.

Balsamic Vinegar of Modena. Discover where true Balsamic vinegar hails from at the Acetaia Tenuta Medici. Learn about the maturation, refinement and aging process of Aceto Balsamico Tradizionale di Modena. Savor a tasting of this sweet yet savory syrup.

Day 6 | Parma | Bologna | Cortona

After breakfast, begin your journey to Cortona. En route, stop to discover the wonders of Bologna.

Bologna. "La Rossa" beckons with its searing red buildings and *porticoes*, covered arched arcades. A walking tour showcases the Piazza Maggiore, the Town Hall and the Archiginnasio di Bologna, the seat of the University of Bologna from 1563-1805. Look above to see the city's symbolic towers.

Continue to Cortona and check in to your hotel.

Day 7 | Cortona

Cortona Walking Tour and the Museum of the Etruscan Academy. Cortona is believed to be one of Italy's oldest towns. While passing historic palazzo and piazzas, admire the town's exceptional Etruscan features. Pass by the Piazza della Repubblica and see the 13th-century town hall and the prominent Museo Diocesano. Discover jaw-dropping vistas of fertile olive groves and Lake Trasimeno from the ancient porta. Enjoy a visit to the Praetorian Palace. Inside, the Museum of the Etruscan Academy boasts rare archaeological finds and Etruscan, Greek, Roman and Egyptian works of art.

Enrichment: Contemporary Italy.



Day 8 | Cortona | Orvieto

A Taste of Umbria in Orvieto. Orvieto stands sentry over the green Umbrian countryside. Join a guide along the cobblestone streets, stopping to visit the Gothic-Romanesque Duomo that boasts a brilliant façade rendered in marble and colorful mosaics.

THE CONNECTS | Olive Oil Mill & Museum. Head into the rolling hills to a family-run olive mill. Discover how the family creates mouthwatering olive oils. Enjoy the buttery flavors of this specialty.

Day 9 | Cortona | Montalcino

Tuscan Countryside and Altesino Winery.

Travel through the patchwork of burgeoning hill country, blanketed with shimmering olive groves, bucolic farmsteads, cypress trees and red poppy playgrounds. enjoy a tantalizing culinary experience at a family-owned winery in the Brunello di Montalcino region. Tour the winery and sample vintages and tasty local cheeses. Raise a toast during a Farewell Reception and Dinner.

Day 10 | In Transit

Transfer to the Florence airport for the return flight to your gateway city.
