A World of Discovery

Connects | *Taste of Umbria.* Visit the Oleoteca Bartolomei Olive Oil Mill and Museum to interact with the family owners, learn about the history and process for making olive oil. Then, savor an olive oil tasting and delicious lunch on the property.

Perugia City Tour. Take a guided walking tour of Umbria's capital city, brimming with medieval pageantry. Stroll the14th-century Piazza IV Novembre city center and plaza. See Etruscan and Roman-period walls, the striking, 13th-century Fontana Maggiore and the iconic, Gothic-style Prior's Palace.

Chocolate Tasting. Visit a local shop in Perugia, renowned for the irresistible Italian Baci chocolate. Learn about the history of its exclusive recipe and savor a tasting.

Orvieto. Venture to this picturesque hilltop town for a guided tour. Walk the narrow, cobblestone streets to the town square and visit the Duomo di Orvieto, a masterpiece of Italian Gothic architecture, see other notable churches and admire the Umbrian vistas.

Day in Tuscany. Start in the Etruscan city of Cortona. Walk past historic palazzos and charming piazzas to visit the 11th-century Cortona Cathedral, and visit the Museum of the Etruscan Academy to see works of art and archaeological treasures. Continue to Montepulciano to stroll past Renaissance architecture, shop, chat with local artisans and peek into centuries-old wine cellars.

Winery & Cooking Experience. Visit a winery to discover the secrets of traditional Umbrian recipes, like homemade pasta and cakes. Watch as the dishes are prepared and savor them for lunch with paired wines.

St. Francis of Assisi. Set out for the walled town of Assisi, birthplace of St. Francis and a major pilgrimage site. Visit the Basilica of San Francesco d'Assisi to view the patron saint's tomb and the Italian frescoes, works of Italian art by Giotto. Also visit the glorious Basilica di Santa Maria degli Angeli, where St. Francis founded the Franciscan order, and later died. Admire the backdrop of Mount Subasio and sweeping views of the Umbrian valley's natural, serene beauty.

Medieval Gubbio. Take a guided tour of this picturesque city at the foot of Mount Ingino. Stroll the elevated Piazza Grande in the heart of Gubbio to the 14th-century Palazzo dei Consoli, famous works of the medieval architect, Giovanni da Gubbio. The historic Corsa dei Ceri festival takes place here as men race on foot, while carrying large, heavy, wooden *ceros*. See the Cathedral of St. Mariano and St. Giacomo, a religious site built over a Romanesque church, and the "Fountain of the Mad," to hear about its interesting folklore.



Todi Walking Tour. Visit this town from the Middle Ages, perched on a hill in the Tiber Valley. Stroll through the central square and see the Cathedral of Saint Mary, the San Fortunato Church and the Renaissance, Santa Maria della Consolazione church. Stop for a picture at the Piazza del Popolo, one of Italy's most photogenic squares.
