Traditions. Discover the Welsh passion for music during a lively, interactive and entertaining session with Welsh musicians.

Conwy Castle. This formidable medieval castle is dominated by eight round towers connected by soaring curtain walls. Tour the castle's royal interiors and walk across the preserved battlements atop the walls to admire sweeping views of Conwy Estuary.

Bodnant Welsh Food Centre. Visit this family-owned farm shop in the heart of the Conwy Valley. Learn about country-fresh Welsh food, peruse the selection of meats, cheeses and produce, and have lunch here.

Bodnant Garden. Explore the rich tapestry of horticultural beauty in these celebrated gardens. Meander along winding paths to admire the formal gardens, Laburnum Arch, Italianate Terraced Gardens and rare plants.

Snowdon Mountain Railway. Board this storied railway for an ascent to the summit of Mount Snowdon. Witness the stunning scenery across Snowdonia National Park.

National Slate Museum. Delve into Wales' slate industry at this atmospheric museum housed in a former quarry. Watch a live slate-splitting demonstration and more.

Isle of Anglesey. Enjoy a scenic tour of this rugged, beautiful island past charming villages and craggy shorelines. Visit the Halen Môn Sea Salt Company to discover the craft and flavors of sea salt drawn from the Menai Strait. Continue to the Menai Suspension Bridge for views of the strait and surrounding countryside.

Caernarfon Castle. Visit this imposing castle, built by King Edward I in the late 13th century as a military stronghold and royal palace. Marvel at the massive curtain walls, polygonal towers, gatehouse and expansive views over the town and harbor.

Snowdonia National Park. Dramatic natural beauty awaits during a leisurely transfer by coach through this stunning region. Take in small villages, lush valleys, tranquil lakes and the icy moorland plateau, with photo stops along the way.

Aberystwyth. In this university town, stroll the waterfront with views of Cardigan Bay.

South Wales. Enjoy a scenic drive through Brecon Beacons and visit Hay-on-Wye, the famed literary haven packed with eclectic bookshops. Afterward, visit the hauntingly beautiful Llanthony Priory to see this 12th-century monastic site nestled in the Vale of Ewyas. Continue to Brecon to explore the historic market town.

Penderyn Distillery. Learn about the Welsh whiskey tradition during a tour and tasting.
