

Day 1 | In Transit

Depart your gateway city for Florence, Italy.

Day 2 | Florence, Italy

Arrive and transfer to the Sina Villa Medici. Get acquainted with your fellow travelers at this evening's Welcome Reception and Dinner.

Day 3 | Florence

Florence Walk. See the premier city of the Italian Renaissance with an expert during this fascinating tour. Stand in awe of the majestic Cathedral of Santa Maria del Fiore, crowned by Brunelleschi's red-tiled dome. See Giotto's impressive campanile, a 14th-century bell tower, and the Baptistery with scenes of the Old Testament on its doors. Explore the Piazza del Duomo, then cross the Arno River via the famous Ponte Vecchio, Florence's iconic stone bridge. At Piazza della Signoria, the city's political heart since the 14th century, take in the stately Palazzo Vecchio and the colossal Fountain of Neptune.

Later, soak up the neighborhood ambience during lunch with your fellow travelers.

Free Time: Follow your own path. Browse in shops or visit one of the many museums.

Day 4 | San Gimignano | Chianti

San Gimignano. Soak up the beauty of the rolling Elsa Valley as you journey to San Gimignano, a lovely Tuscan hill town topped with 14 wonderfully preserved medieval towers. Stroll San Gimignano's red-brick lanes with a guide and learn about the Romanesque cathedral and the Piazza della Cisterna, where locals have gathered and traded since the Middle Ages.

After your tour, pick up some Tuscan cooking tips from a talented chef who will prepare lunch for your group.

Chianti. Taste Tuscany's terroir today in the splendid Chianti region with its olive groves, woodlands and vineyards. At the elegant Castello di Monsanto winery built in 1750, sip wines made from handpicked Sangiovese and Canaiolo grapes, among others.

Free Time: Dine at your leisure this evening. Try Florentine favorites such as tagliolini with truffles or pappardelle served with ragu sauce.

Day 5 | Florence

Accademia Gallery. Explore one of the city's most celebrated museums, which houses Michelangelo's larger-than-life, marble statue of David. Three times the size of a human being, it exemplifies Michelangelo's intricate knowledge of the human form. View Italian masterpieces from the 13th to the 16th centuries as well as an important collection of musical instruments,





featuring pieces by Antonio Stradivari, one of the world's greatest luthiers, and Bartolomeo Cristofori, the inventor of the piano.

Café Culture. Spend time in one of Florence's oldest cafés and relish a traditional drink and pastry as your guide discusses the social rituals behind Italy's delicious national pastime.

Free Time: The remainder of the afternoon is yours to plan. For stellar views, visit the hill-top Piazzale Michelangelo or the lesser-known Giardino Bardini, a peaceful green perch overlooking the city.

Enrichment: Renaissance Art. Broaden your understanding of Renaissance art during a lecture by an expert. Ponder the artists' shift to realism, the changing subject matter, a new emphasis on light and shadow and more. Dine with your group tonight and share the day's highlights, from favorite Renaissance paintings to top picks of pastries and gelato.

Day 6 | Florence

Uffizi Gallery. Navigate this renowned art

Wine cellar, Castello di Monsanto

museum with a savvy guide. Its vast collection features thousands of masterpieces including the exquisite "Birth of Venus" by Botticelli, Caravaggio's gripping "Medusa" and Leonardo da Vinci's "Annunciation."

Free Time: Select a nice spot for lunch on your own during an afternoon at leisure.

Enrichment: Contemporary Italy and Life in Florence. Attend an engaging talk about Italy's place in the European Union and current political, economic and social trends affecting the city and country.

Day 7 | Colle di Val d'Elsa | Siena

Colle di Val d'Elsa. Travel into the Tuscan countryside today and get to know this intimate hill town famed for its centuries-old tradition of crystal glass production. Join your guide for a stroll down its picturesque streets and learn about Colle's position on the medieval trading and pilgrimage routes.

Relax over lunch at a restaurant in the area. **Siena.** Feel the warmth of storied Siena, the





Middle Age gem known for its rosy-pink hue. A guided tour takes you to see the acclaimed, shell-shaped Piazza del Campo; the Torre del Mangia, Siena's iconic bell tower; and Fonte Gaia, the Joyful Fountain, supplied with water from ancient aqueducts. Visit the stunning Cathedral of Santa Maria Assunta, one of the best examples of the Italian Gothic style with an ornate sculptural façade.

Free Time: Meander down the atmospheric streets and perhaps sample sweet Sienese treats like panforte and ricciarelli, chewy almond cookies.

Day 8 | Florence

Free Time: Enjoy a full day to see more of Florence and its environs! Consider a visit to the illustrious, art-filled churches or the Pitti Palace's opulent galleries where the Medici, Lorraine and Savoy families once resided. Steps away, the serene Boboli Gardens invite you to picnic or unwind amid grand Renaissance statues, grottoes and fountains.

Tonight, over an aperitif in the hotel's garden, celebrate your marvelous sojourn with fellow travelers, then gather for a Farewell Dinner.

Day 9 | In Transit

After breakfast, transfer to the airport for the return flight to your gateway city.


