Day 1 | In Transit

Depart your gateway city for Copenhagen, Denmark. ♠

Day 2 | Copenhagen, Denmark

Arrive and transfer \Im to the hotel. After settling in, join your Travel Director this afternoon for a brief orientation walk in the neighborhood. Gather for a Welcome Reception and Dinner.

Day 3 | Copenhagen

Enrichment: Denmark's Viking History. Copenhagen Highlights & Canal Tour.

Take in the acclaimed sites of this cosmopolitan capital city on a guided panoramic/walking tour. Admire Amalienborg Palace, the royal family's residence; the Gefion Fountain; Christianborg Palace, home to the Danish Parliament; the beloved Tivoli Gardens amusement park; and the Little Mermaid statue. Relax over lunch in the colorful Nyhavn district and then get more perspectives of the city during a canal cruise.

Free Time: Explore Copenhagen independently.

Day 4 | Humlebaek | Helsingør | Copenhagen

Louisiana Museum of Modern Art. Set along lovely Niva Bay near Humlebaek, this must-see museum harmoniously presents works of art amid the natural beauty of its verdant parkland beside the waterfront. Enjoy a private guided tour and wander within the Sculpture Park.

Continue to Helsingør for a short walk, free time for lunch and a guided tour of Kronborg Castle.

Kronborg Castle. Immortalized as Elsinore in Shakespeare's "Hamlet," this imposing castle sits at the narrowest point of the Øresund Sound between Denmark and Sweden. Foreign ships sailing to and from the Baltic Sea through these waters were required to pay tolls here to the Danish Crown for more than four centuries.

Free Time: Make plans of your own upon returning to Copenhagen this afternoon.

Day 5 | Kværndrup | Svendborg | Ærøskøbing

Check out of the hotel today and travel by motor coach across the Great Belt Bridge that connects Zealand and Funen Islands. Stop in Kværndrup for a guided tour of Egeskov Castle.

Egeskov Castle. Marvel at one of northern Europe's best-preserved, moated Renaissance castles surrounded by stately, hedged gardens. Head next to the harbor at Svendborg with free time for lunch before boarding the ferry to Ærø Island. Check in to the hotel in Ærøskøbing.

Trough picture-perfect Ærøskøbing this evening with your guide who recreates the role of a Night Watchman, and learn about the town's history, architecture and customs.

Day 6 | Ærø Island | Ærøskøbing

Ærø Island. Explore this tiny island known for



its quiet splendor. Appreciate the centuries-old maritime character of Marstal with your guide, and then relish a tasting, tour and lunch at a brewery. Journey afterward along country roads and through charming towns to the Voderup Klint terraced cliffs for gorgeous views over the Baltic Sea. After making your way back to Ærøskøbing, visit a fascinating little museum featuring model ships in bottles.

Free Time: Take a leisurely walk, rent bikes or browse in the local shops this afternoon.

Day 7 | Svendborg | Odense | Jelling | Aarhus

Check out of the hotel today. Embark the ferry for Svendborg and then transfer to Odense.

Hans Christian Andersen House. Delve into the life story, creative process and works of Odense's most famous son at this innovative museum, and visit the small home where his imagination blossomed during childhood. After lunch on your own in Odense, set off to

Jelling Monuments. Study the 10th-century

Viking runestones that attest to Denmark's origins as a nation and its shift to Christianity, and view burial mounds and other landmarks.

Travel to Aarhus and check in to your hotel.

Day 8 | Aarhus

Enrichment: Denmark's Place in Contemporary Nordic Culture.

AroS Art Museum & Den Gamle By. Lively, inviting Aarhus is Denmark's second-largest city. At AroS, see eclectic artwork and the rainbow panorama of its multicolored rooftop walkway. Afterward, travel back in time at Den Gamle By, or the Old Town, an exceptionally detailed open-air museum that brings to life four different eras of Danish history.

Free Time: After a group lunch in Den Gamle By, spend the rest of the day at leisure.

Day 9 | Silkeborg | Himmelbjerget | Aarhus

Silkeborg. Take a guided walk in this vibrant town nestled in Denmark's lush Lake District, and visit the Silkeborg Museum, notable for the remarkably well-preserved Tollund Man and Elling Woman from the fifth century B.C. Savor smørrebrød, traditional Danish openfaced sandwiches, for lunch at a restaurant.



The shoreline of Vesterstrand Beach on Ærø Island is dotted with charming, traditional beach huts, treasured properties that are often handed down from generation to generation.



Steamboat to Himmelbjerget. Breathtaking scenery unfolds as you cruise in the Lake District aboard the world's oldest coal-fired paddle steamer to Himmelbjerget. Gaze over the expansive landscape from this celebrated hilltop. As you return to Aarhus, stop for coffee in the idyllic village of Ry.

Day 10 | Odden | Roskilde | Copenhagen

After checking out this morning, travel by ferry to Odden. Upon arrival, transfer to Roskilde.

Viking Ship Museum. Gain insights about the Vikings' shipbuilding and sailing expertise at this informative museum, which houses five original Viking ships recovered from Roskilde Fjord and several reconstructed vessels.

Roskilde Cathedral. Trace Denmark's royal lineage at this magnificent church, the official burial place of its kings and queens since the late 1500s. See impressive sarcophagi and ornate chapels on a guided tour.

Depart for Copenhagen and check in to the hotel. Tonight, enjoy a festive Farewell Dinner with your fellow travelers at Tivoli Gardens!

Day 11 | In Transit

After breakfast, transfer \Im to the airport for the return flight \Im to your gateway city.




