Day 2 | Budapest, Hungary

Day 9 | Nuremberg

- •*Nuremberg.* See the city's castle, its lively old town and the World War II courthouse.
- *History of Nazi Party Exhibit.* Visit a special Interim Exhibition that presents the history of the Nazi Party Rallies and the Rally Grounds.
- •*Rural Life.* Experience the tranquil German countryside. Visit a family-run Franconian farm, chat with the family and enjoy lunch.


