### Day 1 | In Transit

Depart your gateway city for Cairo, Egypt. 🌐

### Day 2 | Cairo, Egypt

Upon arrival, transfer ➡ to the Four Seasons Hotel Cairo at Nile Plaza.

### Day 3 | Cairo

**Egyptian Museum.** At this famous institution, view spectacular, priceless antiquities spanning 5,000 years of Egyptian history that illuminate ancient traditions, beliefs and everyday life. Gather for a Welcome Reception at the hotel.

### Day 4 | Sakkara | Giza

**Sakkara.** This vast site served as the burial grounds for the ancient capital of Memphis. Visit the Mastaba of Mereruka, the Pyramid of Teti and the Step Pyramid of Djoser, considered the first pyramid.

Relish lunch afterward at a nearby restaurant.

**Pyramids of Giza.** Marvel at the legendary Great Pyramid, an ingenious masterpiece built for the pharaoh Khufu out of roughly 2.3 million massive blocks of stone, and the enigmatic, imposing Sphinx that crouches nearby.

### Day 5 | Cairo

**Al-Muizz Street & Islamic Cairo.** Stroll along lively Al-Muizz, one of the city's oldest streets, lined with grand medieval mosques and Islamic landmarks. Visit the 13th-century Qalawun complex that contains a madrasa, historic hospital and a mausoleum, and then tour the beautiful, 17th-century Bayt Al-Suhaymi house.

**Free Time:** Explore the Khan el Khalili bazaar. Savor lunch at a restaurant in the area.

**Coptic Cairo.** Step inside the Hanging Church, one of the oldest Coptic Orthodox churches in Egypt, known for its lovely icons. Head next to the splendid Church of Saints Sergius and Bacchus, said to have been built over a cave where the Holy Family sought shelter in exile.

### Day 6 | Cairo | Luxor

Check out of the hotel and fly to Luxor.

**Luxor Museum.** Admire outstanding artifacts collected from the temples and necropolis of ancient Thebes at this informative museum. Check in to the Hilton Luxor Resort & Spa.

**Temple of Luxor.** Sail along the Nile aboard a felucca to this sprawling complex, originally constructed during the reign of Amenhotep III.

### Day 7 | Luxor

After breakfast, check out of the hotel.

**Luxor's West Bank — The Valleys of the Kings & Queens.** Explore this captivating region where New Kingdom pharaohs and

their families awaited immortality. Go inside once-hidden burial places elaborately adorned with vibrant hieroglyphics, including the tombs of Tutankhamen, Seti and others, and visit the colonnaded Temple of Queen Hatshepsut. After a stop at an alabaster workshop, see well-preserved murals in the tomb of Amunher-Khepeshef and the Colossi of Memnon. Embark the Sonesta St. George I for your Nile River cruise. Lunch will be served on board.

#### **The Epigraphic Survey, The Institute for the Study of Ancient Cultures of the University of Chicago (Chicago House).**

Get an exclusive look at the Survey's efforts to preserve ancient cultural heritage through documentation, conservation and restoration. Enjoy a belly-dancing performance tonight.

#### **Day 8 | Karnak | Cruising the Nile**

**Temple of Karnak.** Tour this enormous religious center, which boasts an awe-inspiring hypostyle hall with 134 gigantic columns.

**Free Time:** Set your own agenda on board after lunch as the ship transits the Esna Lock.

#### **Day 9 | Cruising | Edfu | Kom Ombo**

Revel in the Nile scenery on your way to Edfu.

**Temple of Horus at Edfu.** Tour this finely preserved shrine from 237 B.C. with reliefs inside that offer valuable details about ancient religious rituals and political life.

While cruising after lunch, delve into topics of interest at a discussion with an Egyptologist.

**Temple of Sobek & Haroeris.** Learn about crocodile-headed Sobek, the god of fertility, and falcon-headed Haroeris, the god of the sky, at this unusual double temple.

Attend a traditional Nubian show on the ship.

#### **Day 10 | Aswan | Abu Simbel | Aswan**

After docking in Aswan, fly to Abu Simbel.

**Abu Simbel.** Visit the stunning Great Temple of Ramses II, which commemorates triumphs over the Nubians, Hittites and Syrians, and the

temple dedicated to the goddess Hathor. Fly back to Aswan. The afternoon is at leisure. Tonight, celebrate your incredible adventure at a Farewell Reception and Dinner on the ship.

### Day 11 | Aswan | Cairo



After breakfast, disembark the ship in Aswan.


**Temple of Philae & Aswan High Dam.** Sail aboard a felucca to an island complex with a renowned temple to the goddess Isis. After a visit to the Papyrus Institute, check out the 20th-century High Dam, an engineering feat. Fly from Aswan to Cairo and check in to the InterContinental Citystars Cairo. Relax in your evening room before an early morning departure for return flights home.

### Day 12 | In Transit

Very early this morning, transfer  to the airport for your return flights home.
