A World of Discovery

Afro-Cuban Havana. Join writer/activist Roberto Zurbano as he shares secrets of Old Havana on a walking tour. Stop at Beyond Roots, an independent shop that spotlights Afro-Cuban identity, and meet the founder, Adriana Heredia Sanchez.

Regla & Guanabacoa. Visit two Havana strongholds of Afro-Cuban spirituality. In Regla, known for its storied traditions of Santería, Palo Monte and Afro-Cuban religions, see the Church of Our Lady Regla and the black Madonna. Visit Guanabacoa for an intimate cultural experience with a Babalawo priest. Savor lunch of traditional Afro-Cuban foods in a private home.

Cuban Women. Meet Norma Guillard, a Cuban social psychologist, for a viewing of the documentary, "Maestra," about her work with the Cuban Literacy Campaign, followed by an engaging discussion. Sit down for lunch at a female-owned cafe.

Vibrant Havana. On a guided walking tour, stop at a local street market to peruse Cuba's rich array of local produce. Visit the Casa de Africa museum to view its vast ethnographic collection. After lunch, stroll down a lively, colorful alley to experience the Sunday's Afro-Cuban performance.

Cuban Arts & Culture. Delight in a dance performance by a folkloric troupe that helps preserve Cuba's folklore traditions. Visit Casa Fuster, the home and studio of Cuban painter/sculptor Jose Fuster, followed by lunch in his home. Explore Afro-Cuban art at Havana's National Museum of Fine Arts.

Mixology. Participate in a fun class, making Cuban cocktails at El Morro Fortress.

Matanzas. Travel to Cuba's epicenter of Afro-Cuban culture to tour the "Slaves' Route." Visit with African cultural and artistic community groups and individuals with influences throughout the province. Hear a performance by a Cuban rhumba ensemble. After lunch, visit the Sugar Mill Triunvirato museum and see the ruins and the moving Monument to the Rebel Slave.

Vintage Convertible Ride. Experience a delightful, scenic ride in a privately owned, vintage convertible as you drive along the Malecón, Havana's evocative sea drive. Afterwards, visit the historic Hotel Nacional.

Rural Cuba. Take in the views of tobacco and sugarcane fields as you travel to visit Las Terrazas, a model socialist community, to learn about their conservation efforts. Also, visit and talk with the principal at a local school, stop at an artist's studio and relish a lunch of locally grown vegetables.

Afro-Cuban Dance. Learn about Cuban dance from local dancers, who teach tango and Salsa, and try a few steps yourself!
