### Day 1 | In Transit

Depart for Dubrovnik, Croatia. 🌐

### Day 2 | Dubrovnik, Croatia

Upon arrival, transfer 🔄 and embark the ship. Take time to unpack and get to know your ship's amenities. Later tonight, gather for a convivial Welcome Reception and Dinner.

### Day 3 | Dubrovnik | Korčula

**Enchanting Dubrovnik.** Start the day by discovering this history-steeped city by the sea. Witness the Pile Gate, Europe's oldest working pharmacy and the Franciscan Monastery's cloister. See the medieval Sponza Palace and view a baroque cathedral with its collections of art and religious relics. If you wish, walk along the marble-tiled Stradun to scout some shopping options.

Begin cruising along the Dalmatian Coast, a dreamy landscape of towering limestone cliffs.

**Korčula.** The spectacular "Emerald Isle" juts into the Pelješac Channel and brims with natural beauty. Join a guide for a walk through the old town, filled with enduring architecture.

### Day 4 | Hvar | Split

**Hvar Island.** Your day begins at sunny Hvar, known for its lavender plantations, olive groves and beaches. Uncover Hvar's sites, including the Renaissance cathedral and a timeworn community theater. Visit a Benedictine convent dedicated to Hvar's storied agave lace tradition. Croatian lacemaking is on the UNESCO list of Intangible Cultural Heritage of Humanity. Continue sailing beneath blue skies to Split.

**Split.** Behold Split's many riches, including a walk through the courtyards and chambers of Diocletian's Palace. See the Cathedral of Saint Domnius, the Golden Gate and the Peristyle.

### Day 5 | Trogir | Šibenik

**Trogir.** Fall under the spell of Trogir, a well-preserved Romanesque-Gothic town. See the Cathedral of St. Lawrence, the intricate Cipiko Palace and the Fortress Kamerlengo, built in the 15th century. Plus, admire the Benedictine Monastery, founded by St. Ivan of Trogir. After lunch in Trogir, continue to Šibenik.

#### 🌐 PYJ | Choose one of these excursions:

- **Cultural Šibenik.** Visit the UNESCO-listed Cathedral of St. James, one of Europe's most significant monumental churches. Enjoy a wine, cheese and prosciutto tasting!
- **Krka National Park.** Delight in the waterfalls, walking paths and more of this top-rated park. The park features seven waterfalls, including the Skradinski Buk. *(Active)*

## Day 6 | Zadar

---

**Zadar.** This university town is home to an impressive Roman Forum and the Church of St. Donatus. Walk along the waterfront promenade to see modern attractions, including the sea organ. Listen to the melody of this musical art installation, which is fueled by the ebb and flow of the currents. During your outing, sample some unique Maraschino cherry liquor and other locally made sweets. The first recipes of the Maraschino liquor emerged from Zadar during the 16th century!

## Day 7 | Rab Island

---

Settle in for a morning of cruising, passing lovely islands and tranquil coves.

**Rab Island.** Uncover some of the island's marvels, from medieval walls to ancient stone lanes and bell towers. Spy local artists and taste Rapska torta, or Rab cake. Legend claims that the cake was first served in 1177 to Pope Alexander III.

## Day 8 | Krk Island | Opatija

---

Depart Rab and sail to Krk Island, which lies in the middle of Kvarner Bay. Enjoy lunch on board while docked in this charming port. Spend a final afternoon sailing to Opatija.

## Day 9 | Opatija | Plitvice Lakes National Park | Zagreb

---

After breakfast, disembark in Opatija. Head inland to tour Plitvice Lakes National Park.

**Plitvice Lakes National Park.** This park features 16 crystal-clear terraced lakes linked by a series of waterfalls. Wander planked walkways and trails amid a fragrant forest. The area is also home to nearly 160 species of birds and numerous plant species.

After a lunch of regional dishes, continue to Zagreb and check in to the hotel.

## Day 10 | Zagreb

**Elective | Croatian Countryside.** Visit the Antun Augustincic Museum and Gallery in Klanjec before continuing to Kumrovec. The village features an open-air museum with houses from the end of the 19th century and the beginning of the 20th century.

## Day 11 | Zagreb

**Enrichment: Contemporary Croatia.**

**Zagreb Panoramic Tour.** Zagreb weaves European elegance with a vivacious Balkan spirit. After a panoramic tour of the lower town, drive to Mirogoj Cemetery, designed by architect Hermann Bollé. Tour the cemetery, then return to Zagreb's beautifully preserved upper town, home to St. Mark's Church. Gather for a Farewell Reception and Dinner.

After breakfast, transfer to the airport for the return flight to your gateway city.
