A World of Discovery

Old Havana. In Habana Vieja, the historic heart of Havana, take a street-by-street tour of the four main plazas of Old Havana, the largest colonial center in Latin America. Stop at a flea market, chat with vendors, and bargain for Cuban memorabilia. Visit Dador, an independently owned clothing store founded by three Cuban women. Visit the historic, Hotel Nacional, circa 1930.

Cuban Art & Culture. Meet with Wilfredo Benítez Munõz, Executive Director of the Ludwig Foundation's gallery at Havana's National Museum of Fine Arts to view the museum's collection and understand the Foundation's mission to promote contemporary Cuban artists and culture.

Vintage Convertible Ride. Experience a delightful, scenic ride in a privately owned, vintage convertible as you drive along the Malecón, Havana's evocative sea drive.

Mixology. Learn to make signature Cuban cocktails at El Morro Fortress.

Judaism & the Arts in Cuba. Visit the Sephardic Hebrew Center to gain insight into Havana's Jewish community. Stop by local dance company Malpaso to speak to the dancers about their profession and dreams in Cuba, and to see them rehearse. Take a tour of Finca Vigía, the museum/home of Ernest Hemingway. Later, gather on a terrace of the Ludwig Foundation to learn how it promotes contemporary Cuban artists.

Matanzas. Travel to Cuba's cultural hidden gem rarely visited by tourists. Stop at Puente de Bacunayagua, the longest and highest bridge across Cuba, with stunning views over a wooded canyon of the lush Yumuri Valley. Tour Matanzas to glimpse life outside the capital. Pass by the Sauto Theatre and the historical French quarter. Stroll around the city center through Libertad Park and visit a 19th-century French-style pharmacy founded by Ernesto Triolet in 1882. Enjoy a performance by a local choir and chat with choir members.

Cuban Social Issues & the Arts.

Meet Cuban social psychologist, Norma Guillard, to hear about her work with the Cuban Literacy Campaign and women in low-income areas. Stroll to a local street market and then visit a lively, colorful alley to experience the Sunday's Afro-Cuban performance. Visit and enjoy lunch at Casa Fuster, the home and studio of Cuban painter and sculptor, Jose Fuster. Interact with children performers at Casa de la Cultura. Then, learn about tango and salsa!

Rural Cuba. Take a scenic drive to visit Las Terrazas, a model socialist community. Walk through town, visit an artist's studio and a school, and have a farm-to-table lunch.
