

Depart your gateway city for Prague, Czech Republic.

Day 2 | Prague, Czech Republic

Upon arrival in Prague, transfer to your hotel. Free Time: Start exploring this magnificent city. Join a special Welcome Reception this evening.

Day 3 | Prague

Old Town & Charles Bridge. Prague's old town brims with wonders, including the famous astronomical clock and the Charles Bridge.

Free Time: Craft your own path this afternoon.

Day 4 | Prague

PYJ | Choose one of these excursions:

- Lobkowicz Palace & Museum. Witness art, weapons, instruments and other relics. Learn about the life of the Lobkowicz family.
- Jewish Quarter. Enjoy exploring this historic quarter and visit the Prague National Jewish Museum for insight into Jewish history.
- Art Nouveau & Cubist Walking Tour. Gaze at the city's brilliant architecture designed in the art nouveau and cubist fashions.

Day 5 | Prague | Passau, Germany

Niedernburg Abbey, the medieval Veste

After breakfast, transfer to Passau, Germany. **Picturesque Passau.** Venture out to see the many highlights of delightful Passau, including

Oberhaus and St. Stephen's Cathedral. Embark your first-class ship and kick off your cruise during a Welcome Reception and Dinner.

Day 6 | Melk, Austria | Dürnstein | Wachau Valley

Melk Abbey. Visit Melk's Benedictine abbey, featuring frescoes and an incredible library. Cruise through the stunning Wachau Valley.

- Dürnstein. A walking tour showcases the town's architecture such as the abbey church.
- Danube Cycling. Pass by villages and lush vineyards with a guide along the river. (Active)
- Wachau Winery. Visit a local winery for a tour and tasting of delicious Wachau Valley wines.

Day 7 | Vienna

Enrichment: Timeless Vienna.

PYJ | Choose one of these excursions:

- Imperial Vienna. Step inside Hofburg Palace to visit the Imperial Apartments. Continue on an informative drive along the Ringstrasse.
- Klosterneuburg Monastery & Wine. See the monastery's impressive art collection and visit a wine cellar for a special tasting.





• Schönbrunn Palace. Tour this opulent royal residence that was the summer home of the Habsburgs. Enjoy a stroll through the garden.

Day 8 | Bratislava, Slovakia

Enrichment: The Velvet Revolution.

- PYJ | Choose one of these excursions:
- Old Town & Café. A walking tour reveals the Slovak National Theater, Primate's Palace, St. Martin's Cathedral and St. Michael's Gate.
- Old Town & Music. Explore venues linked to Beethoven and other renowned artists, followed by a show by a young musician.
- Iron Curtain Bike Tour. Set off on a gentle cycle along the Slovak-Austrian border, part of the former Iron Curtain. (Active)

Day 9 | Budapest, Hungary

- PYJ | Choose one of these excursions:
- Budapest. See the Hungarian State Opera House, Heroes' Square, the Parliament and Fisherman's Bastion on a panoramic tour.
- Living Local. Browse food and craft stalls in the Great Market Hall. Visit a coffee house for strudel and palinka, a local schnapps.



• Jewish Quarter. Admire Budapest's Great Synagogue, the poignant Shoes on the Danube Bank memorial and other sites.

Budapest by Night. An awe-inspiring evening cruise reveals an illuminated Budapest.

Day 10 | Pécs | Osijek, Croatia | Vukovar

Pécs. Stroll among the Roman ruins and the churches of Pécs, once Ottoman mosques.

AHI Connects | Slavonia Region.
In a small village, visit Rural House and sample tasty Slavonian foods and local products.

Osijek & Vukovar. Tour Osijek with its well-preserved star fortress. Continue to Vukovar to see its baroque city center.

Day 11 | Belgrade, Serbia

Enrichment: Modern Serbia.

- *Belgrade*. Visit the Belgrade Fortress and see the sights in the city center.
- Eat Like a Local. Try delicious Serbian treats like kajmak, a creamy cheese, and more.

Serbian Folk Show. Delight in a lively show, enjoying the melodies of Serbian folk songs.

Day 12 | Iron Gate Gorge

Enter the Iron Gate Gorge, one of Europe's most magnificent natural wonders.

Frühschoppen! Head to the sun deck to tuck into beer, pretzels, sausages and mustards. Join a Farewell Reception and Dinner on board the ship.

Day 13 | Vidin, Bulgaria | Sofia

Disembark the ship this morning.

Vidin. Tour ancient Vidin, viewing the Osman Pazvantoglu Library and other landmarks. Continue to Sofia and check in to your hotel.

Day 14 | Sofia

Enrichment: The Prologue to the Bulgarian Revival.

Sofia Discovery. Witness ancient Serdica, St. George Rotunda, the Alexander Nevsky Cathedral and Alexander Battenberg Square. Gather for a Farewell Reception and Dinner.

Day 15 | In Transit

After breakfast, transfer to the airport for the return flight to your gateway city.
