Day 1 | In Transit

Depart gateway city for Lisbon, Portugal. 🚗

Day 2 | Lisbon, Portugal

Upon arrival in Lisbon, transfer 🚗 and check in to the Dom Pedro Lisboa.

Tonight, join us for a Welcome Reception.

Day 3 | Lisbon

Lisbon City Tour. Begin today along the Avenue of Liberty. Next, uncover Portugal's history at the Hieronymites Monastery where sailors and explorers prayed before their expeditions. Also admire the artistry of the towering Monument to the Discoveries and the Belém Tower, which celebrates the triumphs of Portugal's explorers. Continue to the district of Estrela to glimpse local life.

Free Time: Discover Lisbon at your own pace.

🕒 **Elective | Fado Dinner.** Savor a delicious dinner of Portuguese cuisine and listen to soul-stirring *fado*, a traditional genre of music with guitar and vocal arrangements.

Day 4 | Lisbon

Free Time: Join today's elective excursion to explore nearby villages or enjoy a day at leisure.

🕒 **Elective | Sintra, Cascais and Estoril.** Sintra boasts bright architecture and the celebrated National Palace of Sintra. Walk in the footsteps of Portuguese kings during a guided tour of the palace. Next, take a scenic drive, passing Cabo da Roca and Guincho Beach. Stop in the fishing village of Cascais for a guided walk, and drive through Estoril on your return to Lisbon.

Enrichment: *Contemporary Portugal.*

Day 5 | Óbidos | Coimbra | Porto

Check out of your hotel after breakfast.

Óbidos. Explore one of the most beautiful towns in Portugal! Pretty Óbidos sits on top of a coastal hill and is filled with brightly colored bougainvillea and geraniums.

Coimbra. Coimbra's timeworn streets offer a variety of interesting monuments and landmarks. Visit the illustrious University of Coimbra, one of Europe's oldest universities. See St. Michael's Chapel, a historic ceremonial hall and the stunning Biblioteca Joanina.

After lunch, continue to Porto and embark your ship. Later, join a festive onboard Welcome Reception and Dinner.

Day 6 | Porto | Peso da Régua

• **Porto City Tour.** Explore Porto's historic and modern districts, viewing architectural styles at the Palácio da Bolsa. Visit the Igreja da São Francisco and enjoy a port wine tasting.

• **Porto by Tram and Flavors of Porto.** See the city from a unique perspective aboard one of its old trams. Visit the Museu do Carro Eléctrico, followed by a tasting of local foods.

Day 7 | Porto

- **Guimarães, Cradle of Portugal.** Discover the birthplace of Portugal's first king on a walking tour. Step inside Igreja de Nossa Senhora da Oliveira and visit the Palace of the Dukes of Bragança, an opulent estate. After, craft your own path of adventure in Guimarães.
- **Douro Walk and Port Wine Tasting.** Take a guided walk along the coastline and river. Pass through São Pedro da Afurada, a typical fishing village. Along the way, enjoy a beautiful view of Porto and Ribeira Square.

Day 8 | Vila Real | Barca d'Alva

Vila Real. Take a guided tour of the baroque Manor Solar de Mateus. Admire the rooftop pinnacles, carved wooden ceilings, lavish halls and gardens. Next, walk along the cobbled lanes of Vila Real and sample a local pastry. Gather for a lively Castilian dance show.

Day 9 | Salamanca, Spain

- **Salamanca City Tour.** Explore the notable university town of Salamanca. Visit the ornate cathedral and tour the famous university.
- **Salamanca by Bike.** Bicycle along the Río Tormes and the old town with a guide. Visit the cathedral and the university. *(Active)*

Leading to the church is a grand staircase with 686 steps, nine landings, statues, obelisks and *azulejos*, Portugal's iconic blue-and-white tiles.
