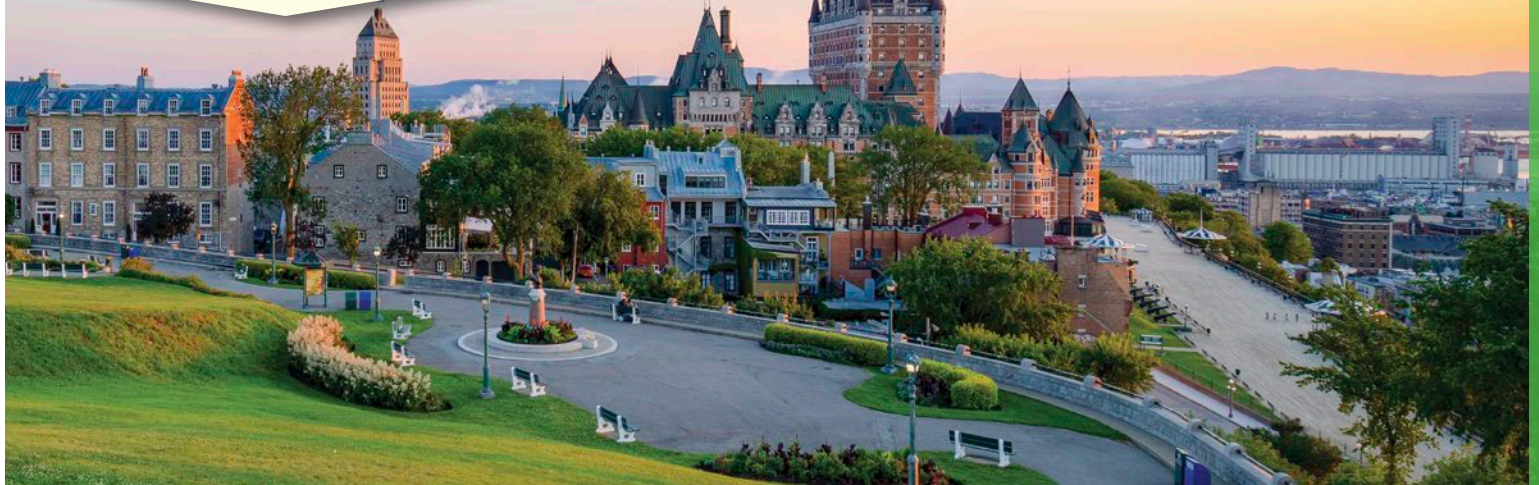

A World of Discovery

AHI Connects | Erabliere du Lac-Beauport Sugar Shack. Learn about Québécois traditions at a family-owned sugar shack and savor dinner featuring folk music and fresh maple syrup!

Ottawa Walking Tour. Hear about the capital city's evolution as you admire the grand Gothic Revival government buildings on Parliament Hill and other top sites. Relax over lunch later in vibrant ByWard Market.

National Gallery of Canada. On a guided tour, view remarkable works by Indigenous and Canadian artists.

Canadian Museum of History. Learn about Canada's First Nations, Métis and Inuit peoples and study striking totem poles on a guided tour with free time afterward.

Rideau Canal Cruise. Travel along this 19th-century waterway, a lovely centerpiece of the city enjoyed by residents year-round.

Old Montreal Walking Tour. See elegant architecture on buzzing Rue St-Paul and in Place Jacques-Cartier and the Old Port, where the city was founded in 1642 on the St. Lawrence River.

St. Joseph's Oratory. In Mont Royal Park, take a guided tour of Canada's largest church. Head next to colorful Jean-Talon Market for free time for lunch and shopping.

AURA at Basilique Notre-Dame de Montreal. Take in a marvelous light show showcasing the church's stunning interior.

Habitat 67. Tour these groundbreaking, modular residences designed by architect Moshe Safdie, part of the Canadian Pavilion for the World Exposition of 1967.

Bourgie Hall at the Montreal Museum of Fine Arts. Attend a musical performance at an intimate concert hall.

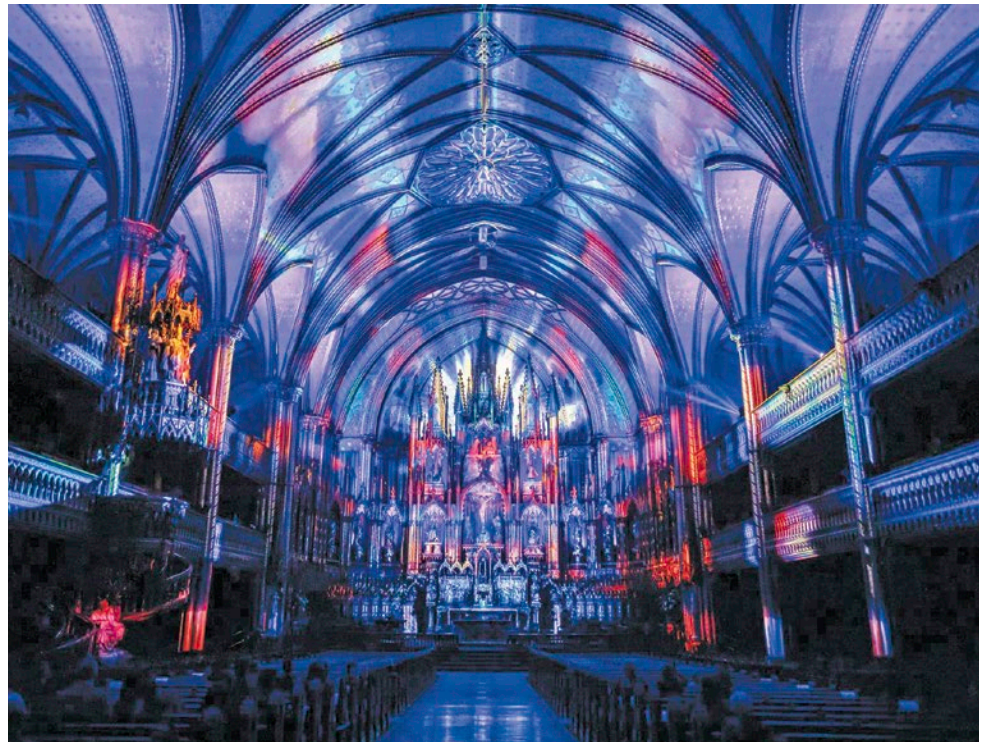
Wendake Huron Traditional Site. Gain interesting insights about the rich culture of the Huron-Wendat Nation on a guided tour. Visit a longhouse and smokehouse, and learn about sweat lodge purification rituals.

Old Québec Walking Tour. Soak up this picturesque district's historic ambience on a stroll and funicular ride. See the Petit-Champlain, the Place de Royal, the magnificent Château Frontenac and more.

Cathedral-Basilica of Notre-Dame de Québec & Citadelle. Tour two icons: the cathedral, a National Historic Site, and the imposing fortress atop Cape Diamond.

Montmorency Falls & Île d'Orléans. Get fantastic views of the falls — 30 meters taller than Niagara Falls — from a cable car. Then, be charmed by the six communities
