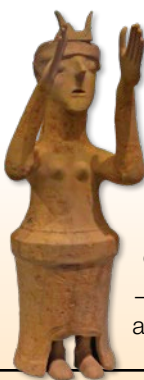

Day 1 | In Transit

Depart your gateway city for Athens, Greece. 🌐

Day 2 | Athens, Greece

Arrive and transfer ➡ to the NJV Athens Plaza. Gather for a Welcome Dinner this evening.

Day 3 | Athens

Athens City Tour. Begin with a scenic tour of Athens' top landmarks. Then, travel up to the resplendent Acropolis with monuments built in the fifth century B.C. by ancient Greece's finest architects, sculptors and artists. Take in the magnificent Parthenon, other grand temples and the city views before studying the Acropolis Museum's exceptional treasures. (Active)

Free Time: The rest of the day is yours to plan.

Day 4 | Heraklion

Check out of the hotel this morning for your flight to Heraklion on beautiful Crete.

Palace of Knossos & Heraklion

Archaeological Museum. Tour the famed archaeological site of Knossos, a majestic palace-complex, and gain insights from your guide about the fascinating Bronze Age Minoan

civilization. Explore buildings adorned with joyful frescoes of dolphins, blue monkeys and leaping bulls. Later, see the Heraklion Archaeological Museum's exquisite artifacts including the original frescoes from Knossos, the Snake Goddess figurines and the enigmatic Phaistos Disc, a Minoan clay disk never fully decoded. Check in to the Lato Boutique Hotel.

Heraklion Tour. On a guided stroll in the picturesque old town, witness the influence of the Byzantine, Venetian and Ottoman eras. See splendid gems like Agios Titos, the city's oldest church, and the captivating harbor guarded by the 16th-century Venetian Fortress of Koules.

Meet at the hotel's rooftop bar for a cocktail and lovely harbor views before dinner tonight.

Day 5 | Anogia

🌐 **AHI Connects | Anogia Tour.** This pretty village on Psiloritis, Crete's highest mountain, offers a wonderful glimpse into rural traditions. Relish Anogia's warm ambience, then head higher up the mountain to see a recreation of a shepherd's house, followed by a lunch cooked over an open fire (weather permitting).

Enrichment: Cretan Culture & Legends.

Free Time: Craft your own agenda in Heraklion.

Day 6 | Matala | Phaistos

Southern Crete: Matala & Phaistos. Venture off to the serene south coast and hang out in Matala, a little beach town with a bohemian vibe. Spend free time exploring or enjoying a swim. Rejoin your group for a guided tour of the archaeological site of Phaistos, the most influential Minoan city in the south, built on terraces over the stunning Messara plain.

Free Time: Return to the hotel for leisure time.

Day 7 | Santorini

Santorini. Travel today by high-speed ferry to this celebrated Cycladic island. Soak up the dazzling scenery of whitewashed buildings against the brilliant blue of the Aegean Sea in the cliffside village of Oia, perched on the volcanic caldera that forms the island. More breathtaking vistas await along the tiny paths of delightful Pyrgos. Sample local wines at a tasting and finish with free time in scenic Fira.

Free Time: Make plans in Heraklion tonight.

Day 8 | Spinalonga Island | Arolithos

Spinalonga Island. Board a boat from the village of Plaka to this rocky islet on Mirabello Bay. Uninhabited today, this former military outpost served as a leper colony from 1904 to 1957. Delve into the island's intriguing history and the heart-wrenching experiences of the people exiled here on a private tour through the atmospheric streets, houses and fortress ruins. Take a break for lunch in Plaka later.

Traditions & Cooking at Arolithos. Tour the Arolithos Traditional Village for a look at folk art and farm culture. Next, learn how to prepare authentic Cretan dishes for dinner at a fun cooking class. Regarded as one of the world's healthiest diets, Cretan cuisine incorporates fresh vegetables and fruits, wild greens and herbs, nuts, cheeses and plenty of olive oil.

Day 9 | Chania

Check out of the hotel and depart for Chania.

Chania Archaeological Museum &

Venizelos House. Examine ancient artifacts unearthed around the Chania region in the city's sleek museum. Afterward, explore the remarkable life and career of Eleftherios Venizelos, one of Greece's most important





modern leaders, at a museum in his former home. Born near Chania, he served as prime minister multiple times from 1910 to 1933.

Enrichment: Contemporary Crete.

Check in to the Avra City Boutique Hotel.

Chania Tour. Take a pleasant guided stroll along Chania’s enchanting, pedestrian-only alleyways. See the colorful, 14th-century harbor with its old lighthouse and end at the restaurant where you’ll dine tonight.

Day 10 | Vouves | Chania

Ancient Olives & Olive Oil. Marvel at one of the world’s oldest olive trees, estimated to be 3,000 years old, in the village of Vouves. Then, learn about cultivating olive trees and olive oil production at the village’s Olive Tree Museum. Sit down for a relaxing lunch in Vouves later. Tonight, embark on a sunset cruise and enjoy a Farewell Reception with your fellow travelers.

Day 11 | Chania | Athens

After breakfast this morning, fly to Athens and check in to the NJV Athens Plaza.

Free Time: Set off to see more of Athens.

Day 12 | In Transit

After breakfast, transfer to the airport for the return flight to your gateway city.

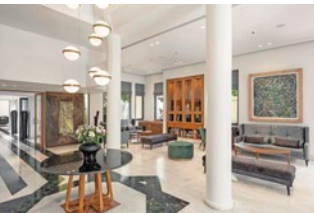

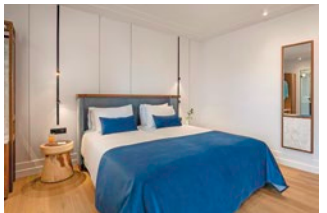

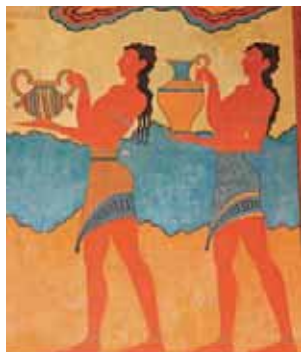
