Discovery

AHI Connects: Bay of Fundy

Lobster Boil. Savor fresh lobster and traditional sides at this quintessential meal!

Halifax. At the Maritime Museum of the Atlantic, explore Nova Scotia's relationship with the sea, from wooden vessels and steamships to its ties to the Titanic disaster. Walk amid the Victorian-era Public Gardens and see the star-shaped Citadel fort above the harbor. Next, head along the picturesque Lighthouse Route to Old Town Lunenburg, North America's finest surviving planned British colonial town and a UNESCO World Heritage site. Finish at Peggy's Cove and see the town's iconic, red-topped beacon.

Annapolis Valley. On your way to Saint John, travel amid this lush region of orchards and vineyards. At the Grand-Pré National Historic Site, learn about the Acadian people and their tragic deportation, then gaze over the Grand-Pré, or Great Meadow, a majestic agricultural landscape. After a winery lunch and tasting, enjoy more valley scenery before boarding a ferry across the Bay of Fundy to Saint John.

New Brunswick Museum. Discover the province's seafaring, shipbuilding and natural history. In the Hall of Whales, get acquainted with the Bay of Fundy's many species, such as the Humpback, Minke and Right Whale.

Whale-Watching. Be on the look out for whales launching out of the water on a Bay of Fundy cruise out of St. Andrews. Drawn by the Bay's protected waters and plentiful food, as many as 12 different species visit each summer to feed and give birth.

Hopewell Rocks Park. Marvel at the surreal, sculptural rock formations carved by the Bay's powerful and relentless tides. Enjoy lunch in Moncton before crossing Confederation Bridge to Charlottetown.

Prince Edward Island. Spend the day exploring Canada's smallest province! Visit Green Gables, the lovely farmstead that inspired Lucy Maud Montgomery's beloved tales of her red-haired heroine, Anne Shirley, and the author's Cavendish home. In the fishing village North Rustico, check out the local color and activity in the quaint harbor.

Cape Breton Island Drive. Admire the island's breathtaking scenery and beautiful Bras d'Or Lake. Visit the Alexander Graham Bell National Historic Site for insights on the remarkable inventor's life and work.

Cabot Trail. Soak up stunning seascapes on this famed, winding coastal road that weaves through Cape Breton Highlands National Park. On your route, see landmarks and visit the small communities of Ingonish.
