

Day 1| In Transit

Depart your gateway city for Cairo, Egypt.

Day 2 | Cairo, Egypt

Upon arrival, transfer **Э** and check in to the Four Seasons Hotel Cairo at Nile Plaza.

Day 3 | Cairo

Grand Egyptian Museum. Take in precious relics that span 3,000 years of ancient history, including an incomparable trove of marvelous objects from King Tutankhamen's tomb. Gather for a Welcome Reception at the hotel.

Day 4 | Sakkara | Giza

Sakkara. This immense burial site served as the necropolis for the ancient capital of Memphis. Visit the Mastaba of Mereruka, the Pyramid of Teti and the Step Pyramid of Djoser, considered the first pyramid.

Enjoy a delicious lunch at a restaurant.

Pyramids of Giza. Marvel at the legendary Great Pyramid, an ingenious masterpiece built for the pharaoh Khufu out of roughly 2.3 million massive blocks of stone, and the enigmatic, imposing Sphinx that crouches nearby.

Day 5 | Cairo

Islamic Cairo. Discover the city's many historic mosques. Inside the Citadel, a medieval Islamic fortress, visit the Mosque of Mohammed Ali. Head next to the Mosque-Madrassa of Sultan Hassan and the grand Al-Rifai Mosque, one of Cairo's largest, where many members of Egypt's modern royal family are entombed.

Free Time: Explore the colorful Khan el Khalili bazaar on your own.

Savor a tasty lunch at a restaurant in the area. **Egyptian Museum.** View priceless antiquities, such as the fabulous treasures of Tanis, at this acclaimed landmark, which opened in 1902.

Day 6 | Cairo | Luxor

Check out of the hotel and fly to Luxor.

Luxor Museum. Admire outstanding artifacts collected from the temples and necropolis of ancient Thebes at this informative museum.

Check in to the Sonesta St. George Hotel Luxor.

Temple of Luxor. Sail along the Nile aboard a felucca to this sprawling complex. Construction began during the reign of Amenhotep III, and subsequent rulers added to it until 323 B.C.

Day 7 | Luxor

After breakfast, check out of the hotel.

Luxor's West Bank — The Valleys of the Kings and Queens. Explore this spellbinding

region where New Kingdom pharaohs and their families awaited immortality. Amazingly, the hieroglyphics adorning the walls of the tombs still spring to life with vibrant color. Go inside several tombs, including King Tutankhamen's tomb and the colonnaded Temple of Queen Hatshepsut. Afterward, stop at an alabaster workshop. Later, study superbly preserved murals in the tomb of Amun-her-Khepeshef, and see the majestic Colossi of Memnon.

Embark the Sonesta St. George I for your Nile cruise. Lunch will be served on board.

Epigraphic Survey of the Oriental Institute, University of Chicago (Chicago House). During an exclusive visit, learn about the Survey's efforts to preserve Egypt's ancient cultural heritage through documentation, conservation and restoration.

Day 8 | Karnak | Cruising the Nile

Temple of Karnak. This immense, ancient

religious center contains many halls, temples and chapels. Be awed by a veritable forest of 134 gigantic columns in the hypostyle hall.

Free Time: After lunch on board, enjoy some leisure time as the ship transits the Esna Lock.

Day 9 | Cruising | Edfu | Kom Ombo

Revel in the Nile scenery on your way to Edfu.


Temple of Horus at Edfu. Visit this beautifully preserved shrine built around 237 B.C. with reliefs inside that offer valuable details about ancient religious rituals and political life.

As the ship sails to Kom Ombo, gather for an engaging discussion with an Egyptologist.


Temple of Sobek and Haroeris. Explore this unusual double temple dedicated to crocodile-headed Sobek, the god of fertility, and falcon-headed Haroeris, god of the sky. Relish a traditional Nubian show on the ship.

Day 10 | Aswan | Abu Simbel | Aswan

After docking in Aswan, fly to Abu Simbel. **Abu Simbel.** Visit the impressive Great Temple

of Ramses II that commemorates triumphs over the Nubians, Hittites and Syrians, and go inside the fascinating Temple of Hathor.

Fly back to Aswan. The afternoon is at leisure.

Tonight, cap off your cruising experience with a Farewell Reception and Dinner on the ship.

Day 11 | Aswan | Cairo

This morning, disembark the ship.

Temple of Philae and Aswan High Dam.

Sail by felucca to this island temple dedicated to the goddess Isis. Then learn how ancient papyrus was created at the Papyrus Institute and see the High Dam, an engineering marvel. Fly from Aswan to Cairo and check in to the InterContinental Citystars Cairo. Relax in your evening room before an early morning departure for return flights home.


