



Day 1 | In Transit

Depart your gateway city for Düsseldorf, Germany. 🌐

Day 2 | Düsseldorf, Germany

Upon arrival, transfer 🚶 to the pier and embark your ship.

This evening, meet your fellow travelers at a Welcome Reception and Dinner.

Day 3 | Düsseldorf

🌐 **PYJ | Choose one of these excursions:**

- **Düsseldorf Tour.** Admire this dynamic city's modern architecture, including the bustling Medienhafen riverfront area, on a scenic tour. Later, take a guided walk in the old town, which boasts a half-mile stretch of more than 250 bars, breweries and cafés. Along your route, try some Altbier, the local dark beer.

- **Aachen, City of Emperor Charlemagne.** Aachen was the imperial capital and favorite royal residence of Charlemagne (747–814), who also enjoyed its therapeutic hot springs. Visit breathtaking Aachen Cathedral, notable for Charlemagne's richly decorated imperial chapel and his original throne. Next, walk in the historic center and spa area, then finish at the city's cheery Christmas market.

Free Time: After lunch on the ship, explore Düsseldorf's six wonderful Christkindlmarkets, featuring themes such as fairy tales and angels.

Day 4 | Cologne

The ship moors in Cologne today.

Cologne Walking Tour. Kölner Dom, the city's majestic cathedral, is renowned as the largest Gothic church in northern Europe. Topped by two filigreed spires, it was constructed over a period of more than 630 years. During a guided stroll, see the highlights of Cologne's old town. Afterward, take in the cathedral's awe-inspiring façade before stepping inside to admire the intricate details of its splendid interior.

Free Time: This afternoon, explore the city center and browse for handcrafted mementos at the Christmas market outside the cathedral. The ship departs Cologne tonight.

Day 5 | Rhine Gorge | Rüdesheim

On the way to Rüdesheim this morning, sail through the Rhine Gorge, a stunning 40-mile stretch of river lined with terraced vineyards and hilltop castles. Famed for its historical, cultural, and geological significance, the gorge reveals charming villages, ancient fortresses and sweeping riverside landscapes.

🌐 **PYJ | Choose one of these excursions:**

- **Rüdesheim Tour.** Take a tram ride along the town's main avenue, Drosselgasse, and stop at the "Christmas Market of the Nations" with holiday items from around the world. At a captivating museum, be amazed by the incredible ingenuity and melodies of music boxes, player pianos and other restored mechanical musical instruments.

- **Rhine Wine Tasting.** Visit the tranquil Abbey of St. Hildegard and learn about St. Hildegard of Bingen, a prominent and multitalented

woman in the medieval church. Later, sample the region's fine wines at a family-run winery.

From Advent wreaths to Christmas baking, learn about cherished family customs at home.


Day 6 | Mannheim | Heidelberg

The ship arrives early in the port of Mannheim.

Heidelberg Castle & Town. Step inside Heidelberg Castle overlooking the Neckar Valley and see the immense wine barrel built in 1591, which once contained 34,342 gallons of wine! Continue with a pleasant guided walk in the old town and along the banks of the Neckar River. Relax over lunch at a German restaurant, where you'll feel the comfortable, friendly ambience known as *gemütlichkeit*.

Free Time: Spend some time on your own in Heidelberg's historic center.

Day 7 | Strasbourg, France

This morning, the ship arrives in Strasbourg, capital of the French region of Alsace.

🌍PYJ | Choose one of these excursions:

- **Strasbourg Panorama.** During a panoramic tour, see Strasbourg's German and French heritage on display in landmarks such as Palais Rohan and St. Thomas Church. Next, take a guided walk in the historic center and behold the impressive Notre Dame Cathedral.
- **Culinary Strasbourg.** Savor the celebrated Alsatian food scene on a guided walk that takes you to the city's *winstubs*, cozy wine pubs, and other local cafés and shops. Taste delicious cheeses, wines, meats and sweets.

Free Time: Catch a complimentary shuttle from the ship to the city center this afternoon and meander in Strasbourg's luminous *marché de Noël*. First established in the 16th century, it's one of France's oldest holiday markets.

Before dinner tonight, gather for a *Glühwein* party with your fellow cruisers. If you haven't already tried it at one of the holiday markets, indulge in this warm concoction of cinnamon, cloves, citrus and wine, a wintertime classic!

Kougelhopf, a famous Alsatian specialty, is a yeasted sweet cake filled with raisins and almonds. The decorative molds used to bake them are often handed down within families.


