A World of Discovery

AHI Connects | Parma's Pastas. Hone your Italian culinary skills while learning how to make tagliatelle, a typical regional dish. After, dig into a feast of your creations!

AHI Connects | Family Olive Mill.

Head into the rolling hills to a family-run olive mill. Learn about the modern methods and ancient techniques for creating mouth-watering olive oils. Enjoy an olive oil tasting and a delicious home-cooked lunch.

Parma. Colorful Parma is packed with regal palaces, gardens and wonderful landmarks. See the Cathedral of Parma, one of Italy's finest Romanesque churches, and the Teatro Regio, the performance home of composer Giuseppe Verdi. Step into the monumental Pilotta Palace complex, a hidden gem, and visit the spectacular Farnese Theater, the court theater of the Dukes of Parma and Piacenza.

Regional Cheeses & Medieval Villages.

Visit a country cheese farm to witness the centuries-old art of turning milk, salt and rennet into tasty parmesan cheese. Explore pretty Castell'Arquato and see the town's highlights, including the stunning Piazza Municipio with its Palazzo del Podestà and the Palazzo del Ducal. Next, step back in time in medieval Vigoleno, one of Italy's most compelling villages. Sit down to a lunch that includes a wine tasting.

Local Delicacies. Discover the rich history of *Aceto Balsamico Tradizionale di Modena* (balsamic vinegar). Learn how the vinegar is made and savor a tasting. Finish the day with a visit to a traditional farmhouse for a delightful dinner of authentic dishes.

Bologna. Discover the epicenter of the Emilia-Romagna region with its miles of *porticoes*, the city's covered arcades. A walking tour showcases Piazza Maggiore, home to the statue of Neptune. Also see the Archiginnasio di Bologna, the seat of the University of Bologna from 1563-1805, and the Town Hall. Plus, get an up-close look at the world's oldest university!

Cortona Etruscan Legacy. Lovely Cortona is believed to be one of Italy's oldest towns. It simply brims with Etruscan history. Linger in Piazza della Repubblica and visit the Etruscan Museum.

Lovely Orvieto. Orvieto perches atop a cliff, delighting visitors with its narrow cobblestones, churches, gelato shops and local artisans. Visit the city's imposing cathedral, decorated with mosaics and frescoes.

Tuscan Countryside & Altesino Winery.

Travel through Cortona's hill country, a land dense with olive groves and vineyards. Near Montalcino, tour a winery and sample its superb vintages and local delicacies.
