A World of Discovery

AHI Connects | Soweto. See the homes of Nelson Mandela, Archbishop Desmond Tutu and Winnie Mandela. In Kliptown, one of the oldest townships, learn about a youth program that offers tutoring and opportunities to play sports and participate in the arts. See a youth dance performance during your visit.

Cape Peninsula. Explore Cape Point Nature Reserve and drive along the scenic Cape Peninsula to the Cape of Good Hope. Visit Boulders Beach to observe life among the 3,000 African Penguins that live there.

Cape Town. Cruise to Robben Island to tour the historic prison buildings and rounds. A former prisoner shares a poignant firsthand story. Next, discover the highlights of South Africa's lovely Mother City, brimming with cobblestone streets and colorful homes. See The Company's Garden, the hillside Bo-Kaap neighborhood and the Victoria & Alfred Waterfront, the city's cultural and historic heart.

Chobe National Park. Spectacular Chobe is hailed for its numerous elephant herds and varied bird populations. The Chobe River gives life to hundreds of animal, bird and reptile species that call the floodplains home. Explore the park during a full-day excursion, including a safari cruise.

Victoria Falls. Revel in the glorious beauty and power as the cascades crash below.

Hwange National Park. Delight in a game drive at The Hide, a private concession in the park that is home to over 100 mammals and 400 bird species. Witness some of the park's residents at a popular watering hole!

Kapama Private Game Reserve Safari. Venture into the amazing South African bushveld on fascinating game drives. Cruise in an open-top safari vehicle to scout for the Big Five: lion, elephant, leopard, rhinoceros and Cape buffalo. Early morning and early evening outings allow you to see a variety of animals in their natural habitats.
