A World of Discovery

Wahl Connects | Arctic Dogsledding. Visit a working kennel where you'll learn about sledding and training, plus cuddle with the friendly husky puppies!

Oslo Overview & Ski Culture. Admire the city's top landmarks, including vibrant Aker Brygge Wharf and the Royal Palace, on a scenic drive. Next, take a guided stroll to see sculptures by the famed artist Gustav Vigeland in Vigeland Park. Later, delve into Norway's 4,000-year history of skiing at the Ski Museum at Holmenkollen, the Olympic ski jump, and enjoy sweeping views of Oslo.

Norwegian Art & Seafaring. View works by Norway's internationally acclaimed artist Edvard Munch, including "The Scream," at the MUNCH Museum. Then, at the Kon-Tiki Museum, learn about the gripping voyages of explorer Thor Heyerdahl. Finish on a high note with a pleasant cruise along Oslofjord.

Bergen Railway. Appreciate the stunning scenery as you travel on Europe's highest altitude railway to Bergen. Cross a plateau at more than 4,000 feet above sea level, and pass fiords, waterfalls and lush forests.

Bergen. Surrounded by seven mountains, cozy Bergen was an important medieval town, serving as a royal residence and a major trading hub for the Hanseatic League. Tour Bryggen, the historic wharf, and see King Håkon's Hall and other famous sites before visiting Troldhaugen, the hilltop home of revered composer Edvard Grieg.

The Best of Norway. Relish Norway's idyllic landscapes aboard the Flåm Railway, one of Europe's most beautiful train journeys. Wind past snow-dusted peaks and through mountain tunnels to Aurlandsfjord, a branch of the Sognefjord, Norway's longest fjord. Enjoy a cruise along this pristine waterway to Gudvangen. More breathtaking vistas unfold on a drive through the Voss district.

Tromsø Overview. Norway's Arctic capital sits roughly 220 miles north of the Arctic Circle. Due to its northerly position and the Earth's tilted axis, the sun never sets here during the summer. Experience the midnight sun phenomenon during your stay! Visit the Arctic Cathedral and ride a cable car up Floyfjellet Mountain for awe-inspiring views.

Nature & Culture of Northern Norway. Delight in lovely arctic and alpine flora at a

Delight in lovely arctic and alpine flora at a botanical garden. Afterward, explore the rich culture of the indigenous Sami people at the Arctic University Museum of Norway with exhibits on reindeer herding, crafts and *joik* music. Take in Arctic wildlife at Polaria, featuring playful seals and an aquarium.

Sommarøy Island. Revel in majestic natural beauty on a visit to the village of Sommarøy and learn about the fishing industry there.
