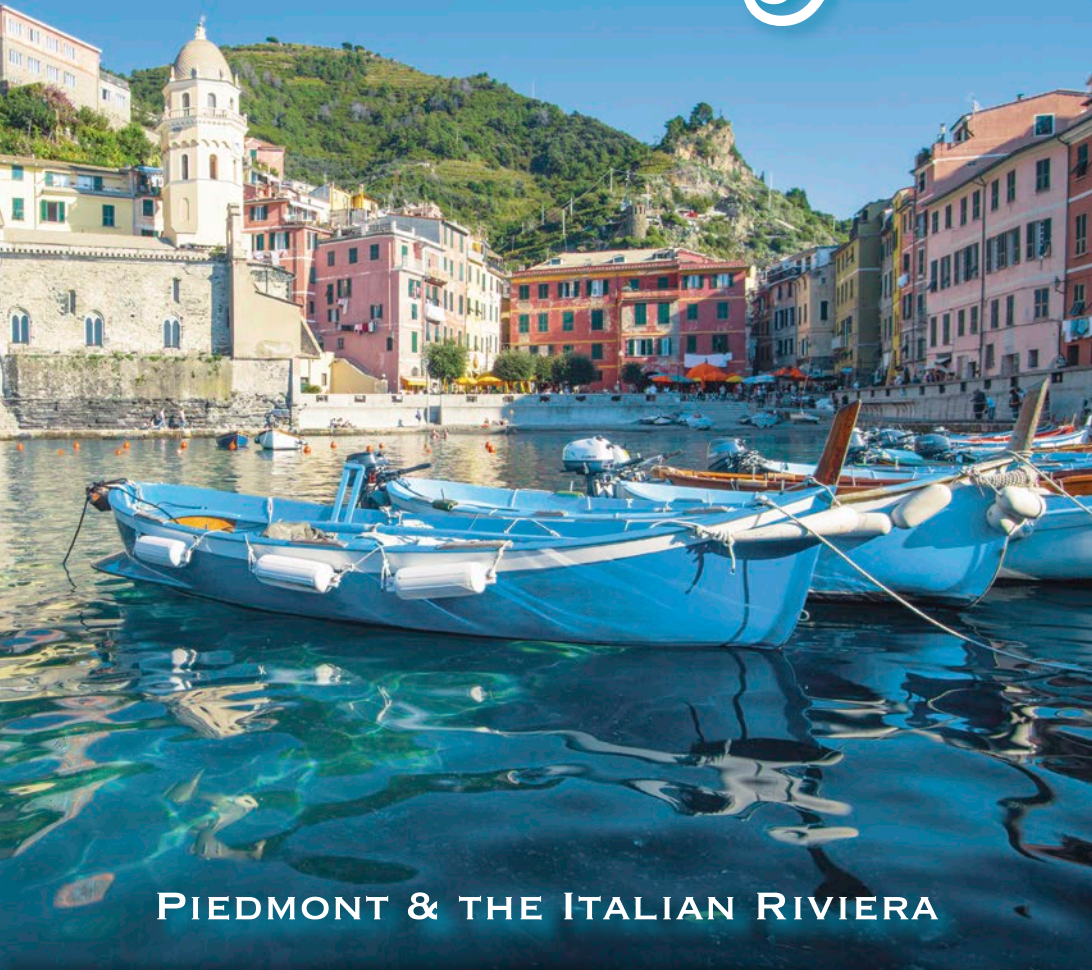

### Day 1 | In Transit

Depart your gateway city for Turin, Italy. 🌐

### Day 2 | Turin, Italy

Arrive and transfer 🚗 to the Turin Palace Hotel. Gather this evening for a Welcome Reception and Dinner at the hotel.

### Day 3 | Turin

**Enrichment: History of Piedmont & the Risorgimento (Unification of Italy).** Gain insights about Piedmont and its key role in the 19th-century movement for Italy's unification.

**Turin Tour.** Admire the highlights of this regal city framed by the majestic Alps. On a guided walk, see the Mole Antonelliana with its iconic spire; Porta Palatina, a Roman-era gate; and the arcaded buildings and baroque churches of Santa Cristina and San Carlo Borromeo in Piazza San Carlo. At a historic cafe, savor a glass of bicerin, Turin's signature drink layered with espresso, dark chocolate and frothed milk. Next, tour the lavish royal apartments and the remarkable armory inside the Royal Palace of Turin, a UNESCO-listed Residence of the Royal House of Savoy. Later, in the Cathedral of Saint John the Baptist, visit the baroque Chapel of the Holy Shroud, built to house the linen cloth believed by some to be imprinted with Christ's face. It features an intricate dome with six levels of overlapping arches. Lunch with your group follows. *Note: The Shroud of Turin is not displayed to the public.*

**Free Time:** Explore more of Turin on your own. Your Travel Director can offer suggestions.

### Day 4 | Alba | Grinzane Cavour | Barolo

**Alba.** Today, head into Piedmont's enchanting Langhe-Roero region, a vision of rolling hills blanketed with verdant vineyards and dotted with medieval castles, where winegrowing and winemaking traditions run deep with archaeological evidence from as early as the fifth century B.C. The region produces two of Italy's most prestigious wines, Barbaresco and Barolo, from the Nebbiolo grape, along with other acclaimed wines. Get acquainted with inviting Alba, the Langhe's largest town, known for its wines, white truffles and chocolate. Stroll with your guide on Via Vittorio Emanuele in the charming old town lined with medieval towers.

**Castle of Grinzane Cavour.** Fantastic views of the open Langhe countryside await you at this grand hilltop castle. During your visit, learn about viticulture and the historic production of Piedmontese wines at the castle's museum.

**Barolo Winery & Lunch.** Indulge in a tasting and lunch at a premier Barolo estate.

**Free Time:** Return to Turin for time at leisure.

### Day 5 | Genoa | Sestri Levante

After breakfast this morning, check out and depart by motor coach for Genoa.

**Genoa.** From the 11th to the 17th centuries, Genoa was one of Italy's most powerful maritime republics, dominating trade and banking. Begin with views of Genoa and its port, one of Italy's busiest, from Spianata Castelletto. Pause for lunch, then take a guided walk through the medieval old town, where



a special highlight is Via Garibaldi, lined with Renaissance and baroque palazzi that once housed Genoa's most illustrious families. See other landmarks such as the Cathedral of San Lorenzo with its black-and-white striped façade and the Christopher Columbus House, believed to be the birthplace of the famed navigator. Afterward, tour the 14th-century Palazzo Ducale, the residence of the Doges who ruled the Republic of Genoa.

Travel to Sestri Levante, a seaside gem tucked in a curve of the Riviera di Levante along the Italian Riviera. Check in to the Hotel Vis à Vis.

### Day 6 | Sestri Levante

**Enrichment: Riviera di Levante: A Painter's Palette.** An expert delves into how artists have endeavored to capture this alluring landscape.

**Sestri Levante.** This resort town entices with sandy beaches along two bays, a vibrant dining scene and an easygoing vibe. On a guided walk, see its delightful architecture, which includes façades painted with trompe l'oeil effects that create ornate illusions.

### Day 7 | Porto Venere | Cinque Terre National Park

**Cinque Terre National Park.** In a country celebrated for its scenic beauty, the coastal Cinque Terre villages stand apart for their arresting grandeur. Once so remote that they were accessible only by boat or a network of mule trails, these five pastel-hued villages hug steep cliffs and ravine slopes at the very edge of the Ligurian Sea. For centuries, residents cultivated grapes, olives and lemons in this challenging terrain by hand-building walled terraces into the mountainsides. Start with a walk in Porto Venere, often considered the sixth village, then continue to Manarola

Next, marvel at the spectacular coastline from the water on a short cruise from Manarola, passing hilltop Corniglia and Vernazza. After disembarking in Vernazza, sit down for lunch at a waterfront trattoria, then return to Sestri Levante by train.

**Free Time:** The rest of the day is at leisure.

### Day 8 | Santa Margherita | Portofino

**The Italian Riviera.** Journey along the coast to pretty Santa Margherita, filled with brightly painted buildings and the gleaming yachts of visiting jetsetters. Then, cruise from there to Portofino, once a tiny fishing village and now a chic playground for the rich and famous. Enjoy a walk on the harbor promenade, followed by free time there. Return to Santa Margherita and find a nice spot for lunch on your own.

In Sestri Levante this evening, toast to your wonderful Italian sojourn during a Farewell Reception and Dinner at the hotel's restaurant, which affords fabulous views over the bays.

### Day 9 | In Transit

Transfer to the Genoa airport for the return flight to your gateway city.

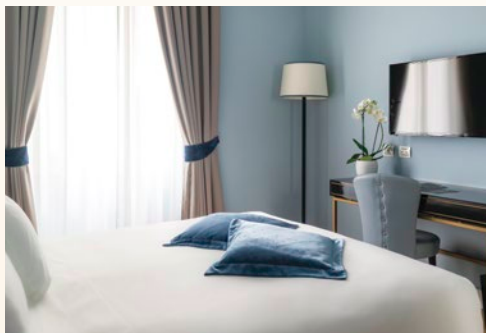

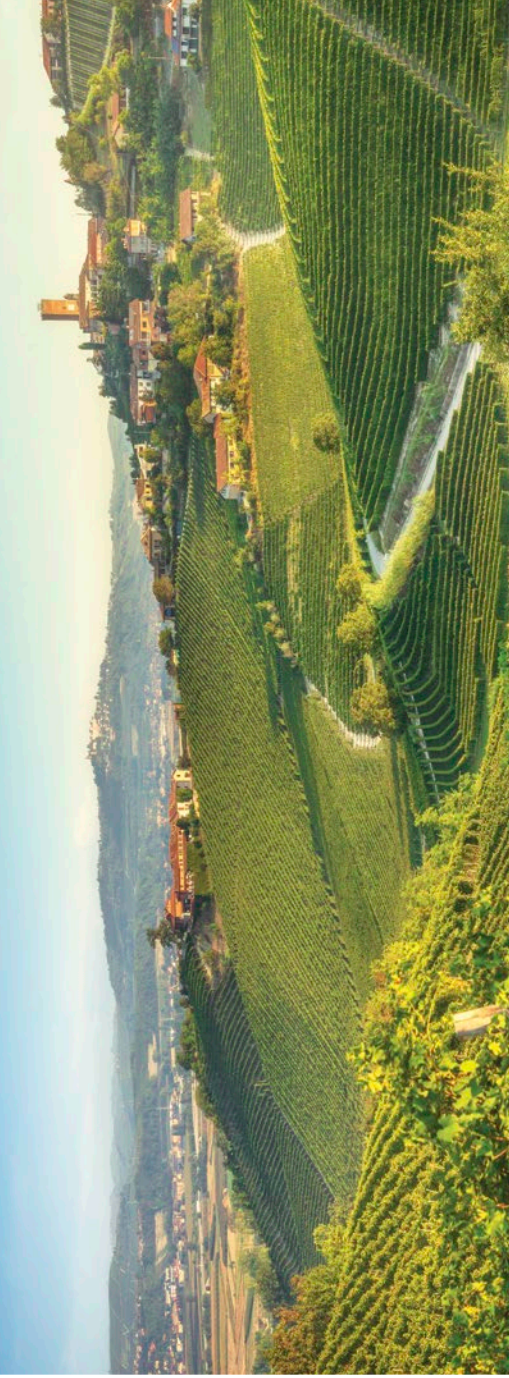
