A native of Poland and a resident of Kraków, Beata grew up behind the Iron Curtain and willingly shares her knowledge about life during that period. She graduated from the University of Kraków with degrees in marketing and management and a specialization in tourism. What first sparked your interest in travel?

A. Despite living behind the Iron Curtain, I had the opportunity to travel abroad as a child. I was struck by the diversity of the countries I visited and surprised by the different customs and mentalities. I quickly realized that traveling broadens horizons and encourages continuous learning and development. Thanks to my knowledge of English, right after my university graduation, I got the chance to work for a U.K. travel agency. It was to be a summer adventure and it continues to this day. Traveling and sharing my knowledge with our travelers has become a great part of my life.

What attracted you to AHI Travel?

A. The best things often happen by accident. A friend told me about interviews for a position in Kraków for AHI Travel on their Alumni Campus Abroad programs. I went to the interview, was selected and have been with AHI for 18 years!

What is your professional philosophy?

Tell us about challenges and successes.

Can you share some inspiring moments?

A. For me, the most important thing is the atmosphere of the place I visit. It does not have to be the largest cathedral or the most visited museum in Europe, but these are important and our programs never miss such places. My great pleasures include getting to know small charming towns on our cruises, meeting locals, drinking coffee in a Lisbon cafe and sampling traditional delicacies at holiday markets. Our programs often offer places off the typical tourist track and this gives travelers a chance to really get to know a country. It's not only the culture that counts, but also the food, good wine or coffee. I cannot forget about the experts who often accompany our programs. He has published widely on travel literature, photography of the Middle East, and Orientalism. His books include Belated Travelers (Duke U. Press, 1994), A Forgetful Nation (Duke U. Press, 2005), and Camera Orientalis (U. of Chicago Press, 2016).

Dr. Susan Kresin | Slavic, East European and Eurasian Languages

Dr. Susan Kresin has been working in the Department of Slavic, East European and Eurasian Languages since 1996. She teaches Czech, Russian, courses on Slavic linguistics, and courses on Central and Eastern European culture that integrate film, literature, music and news media to bridge historical legacies with current perspectives. Her publications include edited collections of articles on Czech culture and on heritagelanguage speakers, a textbook of Czech, and articles on language pedagogy, comparative linguistics, and corpus-based linguistics. Her current focus of integration in language and area studies courses is media literacy.

UCLA Distinguished Professor Glen MacDonald has travelled the globe uncovering evidence of climate change and its impacts on the environment and on human societies. He uses a variety of research techniques that allow him to study climate change, and the history of the Earth's environments and people as it happens today and back thousands of years into the past. Glen will share with you how geography and past climate change have shaped the landscapes of the Rhine region and influenced the histories of its peoples and places. He will also consider how current climatic changes are impacting the 21st century. Along the way Glen will share some of the adventures he has experienced during his many scientific expeditions.



Kathryn Norberg | History

Kathryn Norberg has taught in the UCLA Department of History for 32 years. She is a historian of Europe, specializing in French history before 1800. She is the author or editor of six books and many articles dealing with topics as diverse as the history of charity, French peasant communities, national debt crises, women during the French Revolution, eighteenth-century furniture and clothing in fashion prints. A past president of the Western Society for French history, she has taught courses on prehistory, late medieval France and royal courts. She has traveled widely in provincial France, researching projects in more than 20 French cities and Montreal, Canada. She also works in women's and gender history and twice served as Acting Chair of the UCLA Gender Studies Department. Recent projects have given Norberg a passion for military history and material culture, especially history of architecture, clothing and food.

Teo Ruiz | History

Teofilo Ruiz received his doctorate from Princeton University and has taught at many universities, including the University of Michigan and Princeton. He served as UCLA History Department chair (2002-2005) and chair of the Department of Spanish and Portuguese (2008-2009). A medievalist and early modern historian, Ruiz was selected by the Carnegie Foundation as one of the four Outstanding Teachers of the Year in 1994. The author of 14 books, he received the prestigious 2007 Guggenheim Fellowship and the Distinguished Teacher Award at UCLA. In 2012, Ruiz was selected as the Senior Research Lecturer at UCLA and received the National Humanities Medal from President Obama. With 18 past tours, Professor Ruiz is the most popular and beloved lecturer traveling with UCLA Alumni Travel.


Michael Shin | Geography

Professor Michael Shin is a faculty member in the UCLA Department of Geography who specializes in contemporary Italian society, politics and culture. Since joining UCLA in 2001, Michael has published several articles and two books on political change in Italy, the rise of populism in Italy, Europe and the US, and Italy's infamous leader, Silvio Berlusconi. Mild | Walk under 1 mile on mainly flat terrain; navigate under 50 stairs; stand under 1 hour

Utah Beach and Sainte-Mère-Église. The Normandy coastline provided the theater for Operation Overlord, one of history's largest and most complex military operations. In the very early hours of June 6, 1944, paratroopers and glider units arrived inland, tasked with sealing off German access to the amphibious assault sites. By daybreak, the second phase began as infantry and tanks came ashore on five beaches codenamed Utah, Omaha, Gold, Juno and Sword. At the Musée du Débarquement at Utah Beach, hear gripping details from your guide about how the invasion unfolded. Day 7 | Córdoba

Córdoba. A UNESCO World Heritage site, Córdoba's mosque-cathedral, La Mezquita, contains the finest examples of Moorish architecture in Spain. While the mosque was built in the eighth century, the cathedral was erected in the 16th century after Spanish forces recaptured Córdoba in 1236. Its combination of Islamic and Christian decorative elements dazzles the eye, including the prayer hall of striped arches, the golden mihrab, the altar screen and the mahogany choir stalls.
