## A World of Discovery

**AHI Connects | Mali Ston Oyster Farm.** Board a boat in the fishing village of Mali Ston. Ride across Mali Ston Bay to visit an oyster farm. Taste delicious bivalves, fresh from the sea, accompanied by wine.

**AHI Connects | Lavender Farm & Winery.** Soak up the purple beauty and delightful fragrance of lavender during a visit to family-run lavender farm. The blossoms are grown for medical, cosmetic, cooking and a variety of other products. Continue to Tomić Winery, run by Andro Tomić. Learn about the history of winemaking in the Tomić family and enjoy a guided tasting of the family's legendary wines.

**Zagreb.** Find European elegance and a vivacious Balkan spirit on a panoramic tour. Witness the modern Lower Town, visit Mirogoj Cemetery and see the Upper Town. Witness the city's remarkable Austro-Hungarian architecture, St. Mark's Church, the Cathedral of Assumption and more!

**Plitvice Lakes National Park.** This splendid natural wonder flaunts 16 crystal lakes laced together in a series of turquoise cascades. Walk along planked walkways and trails amid beech and pine trees, and look for endemic species throughout the park.

**Zadar.** Uncover romance and ancient architecture in Zadar, from the impressive walls and gates of the Roman Forum to the Byzantine-style St Donat church. Enjoy modern attractions at the promenade, including the Sea Organ, a musical art installation, and the Monument to the Sun. Taste locally made Maraschino liquor!

**Šibenik.** Uncover the architecture of Šibenik at UNESCO-listed Cathedral of St. James, one of Europe's most significant monumental cathedrals. This magnificent church was built only in stone during the 15th and 16th centuries. It was also featured on the "Game of Thrones."

**Split.** Delight in the riches of Split while roaming the courtyards and chambers of Diocletian's Palace, and see the stunning Cathedral of Saint Domnius, the Golden Gate and the Peristyle.

**Hvar's Stari Grad.** Uncover a slice of paradise in the ancient port town of Stari Grad, Croatia's oldest town. Notice the churches, quaint squares and orange-tiled rooftops clustered around the charming marina. Next, visit Vrboska, a hidden treasure filled with fig-covered courtyards, intricate dwellings and pretty alleyways.

**Korčula.** The spectacular "Emerald Isle" juts into the Pelješac Channel and brims with beauty. Join a guide to discover the old town's architecture. Korčula is also rumored to be the birthplace of Marco Polo!

**Pelješac Peninsula.** Discover the ruggedly

beautiful Pelješac Peninsula, brimming with sensational sights. Visit the centuries-old salt pans at Ston, some of the world's oldest and most well-preserved salt harvesting sites. See the imposing Great Wall of Ston that links Ston to Mali Ston.

**Dubrovnik.** Glamorous Dubrovnik boasts medieval churches and relaxing public spaces. Visit the Franciscan Monastery's Romanesque cloister, Europe's oldest working pharmacy and pass by Sponza Palace.

**Ljubljana.** Discover the Old Town with its baroque and Renaissance architecture. Browse the bustling Central Market and visit Prešeren Square, home to the pink Franciscan Church of the Annunciation. Walk through Congress Square, see the University of Ljubljana and step inside the Ljubljana Cathedral. Enjoy strolling along the Ljubljanica River, passing iconic bridges, including the Triple Bridge and the striking Dragon Bridge, guarded by four mighty dragons.
