



Day 1 | In Transit

Depart your gateway city for Milan, Italy.

Day 2 | Milan, Italy | Stresa

Upon arrival, transfer **3** to Stresa and check in to the Hotel La Palma. Take time to explore Stresa, enjoying the town's old-world ambience and dramatic vistas.

This evening, join your fellow travelers for a Welcome Reception and Dinner at the hotel.

Day 3 | Stresa | Lake Orta

Enrichment: The Development of the Lake

District. After breakfast, join a local expert to learn about Italy's captivating Lake District, a haven of Alpine peaks, gardens and lakes.

Lake Orta. Enjoy a scenic drive to Orta San Giulio, built on a promontory that juts into the lake. During a walking tour, see the central piazza dotted with rainbow-hued umbrellas. Cruise to Isola San Giulio, a sweet oasis with pedestrian-friendly roads, historic buildings and an ancient basilica.

Free Time: Craft your own path in San Giulio. Follow narrow lanes, pausing to marvel at the village's colorful houses and small chapels.

Day 4 | Borromean Islands

Free Time: Set off to explore lovely Stresa.

Borromean Islands. Cruise on Lake Maggiore to Isola Madre, the largest of the Borromean Islands, and take a guided tour of the lush English-style botanical gardens. Next, embrace the charms of Isola dei Pescatori, which offers a glimpse into Lake Maggiore's storied fishing tradition. Continue to Isola Bella, "The Beautiful Island," and enjoy an exclusive tour. These stunning grounds feature a palatial palace and awe-inspiring gardens filled with fragrant citrus trees, water-wheel towers, statues and peacocks. Cap off your excursion with a private reception in the island's terraced hanging gardens. Savor some tasty aperitifs while appreciating this slice of Italian paradise!

Day 5 | Bellagio | Como

Bellagio. Journey by coach and boat to charming Bellagio. This lakeside retreat feels like a storybook. In fact, writers from around the world have found inspiration here, including Longfellow and Mark Twain. Delight in the

town's promenade lined with lime trees and flower boxes, and see the quaint city center, with cobblestone streets and homes painted in rich reds and butterscotch yellows. During a stroll, pass by silk shops and gelato stores before sitting down to a satisfying lunch at a lakeside restaurant.

Free Time: Discover the magic of Bellagio on your own during leisure time.

Cruising Lake Como. Your scenic cruise by private boat unveils the region's natural splendor. As you glide along, celebrate vistas of azure waters bathed in sunlight. Let your gaze travel to the shore, where elegant villas and brightly painted villages peek from gardens, woodlands and pebbled shorelines. Breathe in the fresh air, sit back and let the vistas captivate your senses. Upon arrival in Como, join your group for a walking tour beginning in Piazza Cavour.

Day 6 | Stresa

Enrichment: *Golden Age of the Renaissance.* Delve into the true genius of Michelangelo and Leonardo da Vinci while tracing their profound influences on sculpture and painting.

Connects | *Flavors of Italy.* Learn the secrets of northern Italian cuisine during an interactive cooking lesson at a restaurant overlooking Lake Maggiore.

Free Time: Enjoy the remainder of the day at leisure. Soak up a sunset by the harbor or settle in at a local café for a snack or cocktail.

Enrichment: *Contemporary Italy.* Join a local expert to discuss Italy's economy, politics and role in the European Union.

Day 7 | Milan

A Cultural Visit to Milan. Fast-paced, chic Milan is Italy's economic powerhouse. From superb architecture and art to world-class museums, Milan is host to a wealth of cultural







heritage. Begin at the Church of Santa Maria delle Grazie to stand before Leonardo's remarkable "The Last Supper." This powerful painting is hailed as one of the greatest in the world. The masterpiece took more than two years to complete and da Vinci used models from the streets of Milan for his depictions of Christ and his followers. Continue to the museum at La Scala. See the 14th-century Duomo, a flamboyant architectural wonder with 2,244 marble saints and nearly 100 scowling gargoyles.

Free Time: Spend time at leisure having lunch and getting to know cosmopolitan Milan. Perhaps browse prestigious boutiques along Milan's elegant shopping streets.

Day 8 | Stresa

Free Time: There are endless opportunities to pursue your own interests during a day at leisure. Settle in for an aperitivo on your hotel's rooftop bar or relax in the comforting breezes along Stresa's lakefront promenade.

Raise a toast to your Italian adventure during a festive Farewell Reception and Dinner.

Day 9 | In Transit

After breakfast, transfer **3** to the Milan airport for the return flight **4** to your gateway city.
