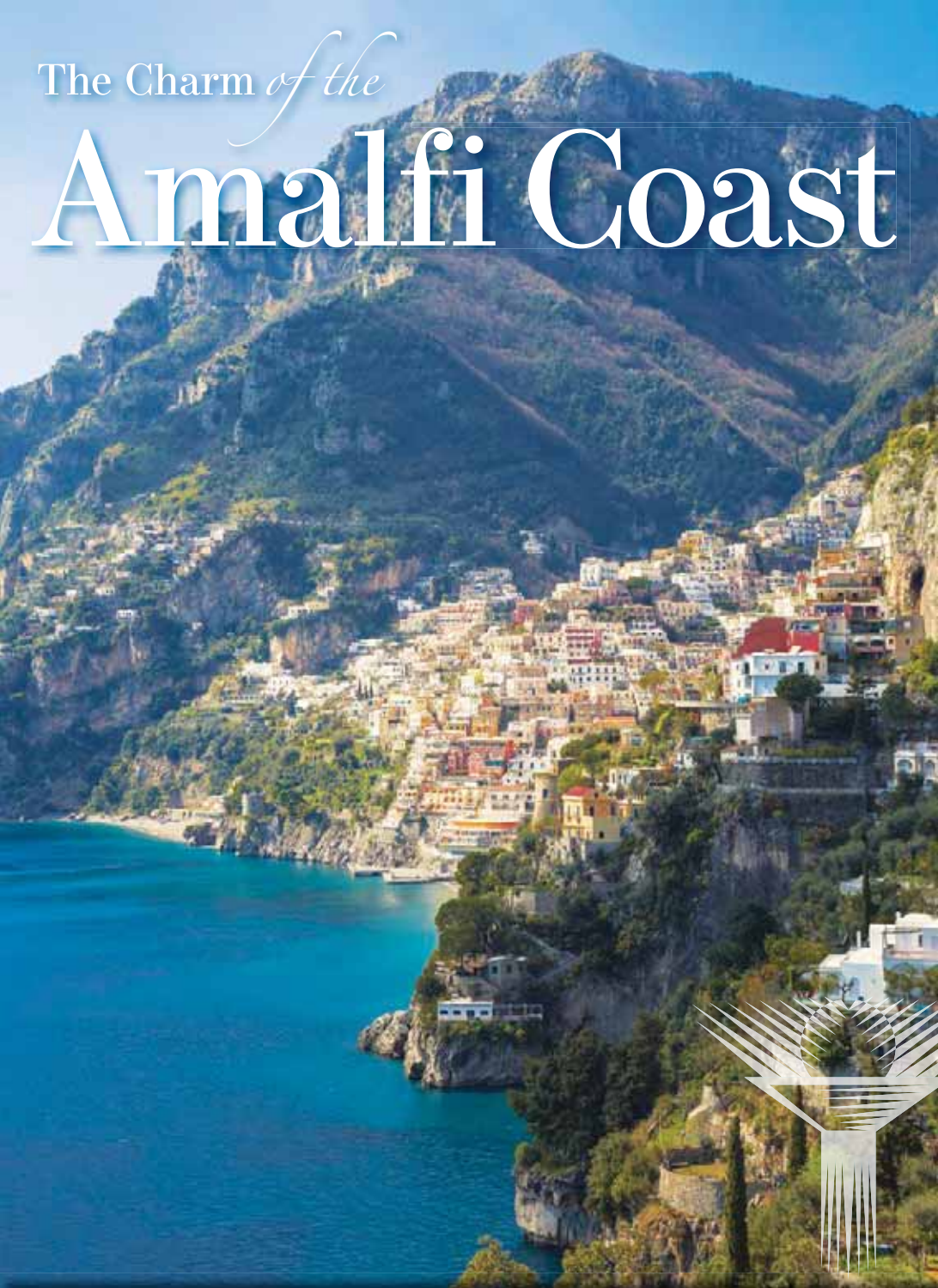

She is the author or editor of seven books and many articles dealing with topics as diverse as the history of charity, fiscal crises, women in revolution, and eighteenth-century furniture and fashion prints in the age of Louis XIV. Her most recent project analyzes life in an eighteenth-century brothel. Her teaching at UCLA covered Europe from the Ancients to the internet. She is particularly interested in Roman history. 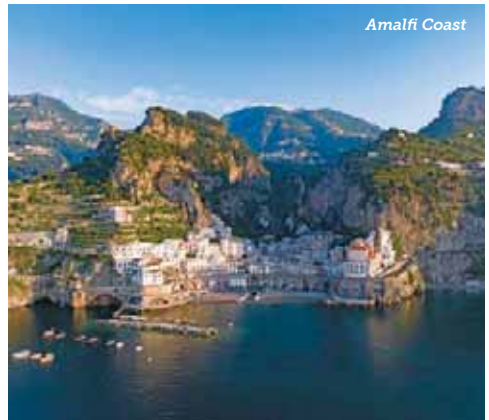

Day 1 | In Transit

Day 2 | Naples, Italy | Vietri sul Mare

Arrive in Naples, transfer 🔄 to Vietri sul Mare and check in to the Hotel Raito.

Day 3 | Amalfi | Positano

The Amalfi Coast. Experience the beauty and wonders of the UNESCO-listed Amalfi Coast. The Italians nicknamed this shoreline "The Divine Coast" because of its scenic grandeur, amazing vertical landscapes and small villages with colorful, varied architecture. Begin in Amalfi town and take an orientation tour to see the piazza, the central square and Cattedrale di Sant' Andrea. After some leisure time to explore Amalfi, board a boat for a ride to Positano. During your cruise, notice the charming villages and pastel-colored villas clinging to the cliffs. Arrive in Positano, where gardens climb hillsides and terraces are draped with pink bougainvillea. Return to Vietri sul Mare and gather for a delicious dinner of regional cuisine.

Day 4 | Paestum

Paestum. Explore these ancient grounds, a UNESCO World Heritage site. This Greco-Roman city was overgrown by vegetation and forgotten for 1,000 years. Marvel at the features of the spectacular site, including defensive walls, the remains of three Doric-style temples and a host of impressive ruins.

Enrichment: The Wonders of Naples' National Museum. Join a local expert to learn about this renowned museum and its art collections and riveting artifacts.

Day 5 | Naples

Naples & the Museo Archeologico Nazionale. Energetic Naples, the capital city of Campania, welcomes visitors with a vivacious spirit. Gain insight into the ancient world at the Museo Archeologico Nazionale. The museum's galleries boast one of the largest collections of Greco-Roman artifacts in the world. Continue on a panoramic tour of Naples, taking in sprawling views of the city and the Bay of Naples from atop Posillipo Hill. Note the landmarks of Castel Nuovo, San Francesco di Paola, Teatro di San Carlo and Piazza del Plebiscito.

Day 6 | Vietri sul Mare

Free Time: Choose to visit the Isle of Capri or stay in Vietri sul Mare for a day at leisure.

Elective | *The Isle of Capri.* Travel by hydrofoil to the enchanting Isle of Capri, beloved by artists and writers through the centuries. Enjoy a private boat ride around the island, witnessing the Faraglioni rocks and pretty grottos. Back on land, stroll along Capri's scenic lanes, visit the Gardens of Augustus or snack on gelato.

Enrichment: *The Horror and Splendor of Mount Vesuvius.* Learn about the tragic effects of the eruption of Mount Vesuvius. This compelling talk provides context for tomorrow's visit to Herculaneum and Pompeii.

Day 7 | Herculaneum | Pompeii

Herculaneum & Pompeii. Spend the day exploring these captivating Roman cities. The small town of Herculaneum was preserved by mudflows while Pompeii was covered by ash. The preservation of the cities is unlike anything else in the world. Today, they are famous as an excavation site and outdoor museum that reveal how the people of this ancient Roman settlement lived 2,000 years ago. From mosaics to furniture to frescoes, unearth a captivating history lesson as you tour the Forum, baths and houses.

Relax over lunch during your excursion.

Enrichment: *Contemporary Italy.* Enjoy a discussion about Italian society, life in Campania, the current political and economic situation in Italy and the country's challenges. Savor Italy's delectable dishes during dinner.

Day 8 | Sorrento

Get to Know Sorrento. Travel to cheery Sorrento, surrounded by lemon groves. During an orientation tour, walk along the Corso Italia and Via San Cesareo. Sorrento's magical old town is bursting with lively shops, market stalls and alfresco cafes. Along the way, snap photos of the glistening Bay of Naples and Mount Vesuvius in the distance.

Green Side of Sorrento. Journey inland to a local farm where skilled agriculturists have a passion for their land. Tour groves of olive trees, learn how fresh-picked olives are ground into delicious olive oils and see how to make fior di latte, a semi-soft cheese. Sample this traditional treat and other local products.

Free Time: Spend the afternoon at leisure in Vietri sul Mare. Browse for souvenirs from the many boutiques and shops.

Raise a toast to your Italian adventure at a Farewell Reception and Dinner tonight.
