Day 1 | In Transit

Depart your home city for Munich, Germany. 🌐

Day 2 | Munich, Germany | Passau

Arrive and transfer 🔄 to Passau to embark on the ship. Early arrivals can join a walking excursion of Passau to see some of the city's highlights.

Tonight, meet your fellow travelers at a festive Captain's Welcome Reception and Dinner.

Day 3 | Regensburg

Historic Regensburg Walking Tour. Explore one of Germany's most charming towns to see iconic landmarks, including the ancient Roman tower and gateway of Porta Praetoria, the 12th-century Stone Bridge, the Altes Rathaus bright yellow Town Hall dating back to the 1200s and the enthralling St. Peter's Cathedral with its stunning stained-glass windows. Visit the Thurn und Taxi Palace to learn about its rich history and see the ballroom and throne room.

Enrichment: Main-Danube Canal. Discuss the history and importance of Europe's greatest man-made passageway with a local expert.

Gather for dinner on board this evening as the ship enters the Main-Danube Canal.

Day 4 | Nuremberg

Wake this morning to the Nuremberg cityscape.

🌐PYJ | Choose one of these excursions:

- **Sights of Nuremberg.** Join a panoramic drive through the city, passing by the courthouse that held the World War II trials. See the renowned hilltop castle, lively old town and

14th-century Gothic fountain, known as the city's most famous attraction, on a guided walking tour.

- **History of Nazi Party Exhibit.** Visit a special Interim Exhibition that presents the history of the Nazi Party Rallies and the Rally Grounds.

This evening, head to the Sun Deck to capture photos of the breathtaking scenery as the ship sails through the Main-Danube Canal.

Day 5 | Bamberg

Arrive in endearing Bamberg this morning.

🌐PYJ | Choose one of these excursions:

- **Bamberg Walking Tour.** Witness colorful Gothic and baroque masterpieces on a guided walking tour of this fairy-tale town. Visit the most famous fountain in Bamberg to see its centerpiece, the statue of Neptune. Then, continue towards the Obere Brücke and wander under the grand rococo archway to marvel at the red-roofed fishermen's houses and baroque mansions of Bamberg.

- **AHI Connects | Culinary Delights.**

Learn about and sample local delicacies with Bavarian and Franconian influences during a culinary tour of Bamberg. Walk the town to visit a local deli, bakery, butcher shop and candy store.

Return to the ship and utilize its many amenities as you cruise leisurely towards Würzburg.

Day 6 | Würzburg

Disembark for the day and enjoy a scenic drive to Würzburg, a romantic region of Bavaria.



PYJ | Choose one of these excursions:

- **Würzburg Residenz & City Walk.** Relish a visit inside one of the finest baroque palaces in Europe. The renowned Würzburg Residence boasts its Imperial Hall, the Hall of Mirrors and an impressive staircase with a brilliant fresco. Stroll through the city center to see St. Kilian's Cathedral, the Neumünsterkirche, the Old Town Hall and the scenic market square.
- **Romantic Road.** Traverse the Franconian heartland along the Romantic Road, a famous historic path that offers captivating views of the varying landscapes, fairy-tale castles and alleyways decorated with colorful blooms. Then, spend time in the well-preserved medieval city, Rothenburg ob der Tauber.

Day 7 | Miltenberg

Miltenberg Walking Tour. Stroll through picturesque Miltenberg to relish the traditional half-timbered houses, historic taverns and 16th-century octagonal fountain. See the Town Hall and Germany's oldest working inn, Zum Riesen, with its storybook facade. Enjoy a liqueur tasting at St. Kilian Kellerei, a wine shop set above a 15th-century vaulted cellar.

Culinary Experience. Gather for lunch to experience a German tradition. Sip and socialize as you enjoy a local beer paired with fresh pretzels, sausages and mustards.

Day 8 | Koblenz

Koblenz Discovery. Wander the cobblestone lanes through this storied town, established over 2,000 years ago at the confluence of the Rhine and Moselle rivers. View awe-inspiring landmarks within Koblenz, including the Town Hall, the Church of Our Lady, the Old Castle and the Old Merchants' Hall. Continue to see the notable monument of Emperor Wilhelm II, situated on the German Corner.

Free Time: Spend the remainder of your evening in beautiful Koblenz at leisure.

Day 9 | Koblenz | Cochem

Witness colorful villages and tiered vineyards as you sail from Koblenz to Cochem through a narrow portion of the Moselle River.

Enrichment: Moselle Wine Tasting. Learn about and sample wines from the Moselle region with a sommelier from a nearby winery.
