Day 1 | In Transit

Depart your gateway city for Istanbul, Turkey. 🌐

Day 2 | Istanbul, Turkey

Arrive and transfer 🔄 to the Barceló Istanbul Hotel. This evening, meet your fellow travelers at a Welcome Reception and Dinner.

Day 3 | Istanbul

Enrichment: *Istanbul, The Crossroads of the World.*

Istanbul: Part 1. Meander through the aromatic Spice Bazaar brimming with spices, teas and treats, and take a guided tour of the majestic, 16th-century Süleymaniye Mosque built by Sultan Suleiman the Magnificent. Finish with a pleasant cruise along the Bosphorus Strait.

Free Time: The rest of the day is yours to plan.

Day 4 | Istanbul

Istanbul: Part 2. Visit the ornately tiled Topkapı Palace, the imperial residence of the Ottoman sultans for almost four centuries, and view its dazzling, jewel-encrusted artifacts. See the Hippodrome of Constantinople, a former Roman arena where chariots raced, and go down into the atmospheric Basilica Cistern, an underground reservoir. You'll also tour two exquisite gems: the mammoth, Byzantine-era Hagia Sophia Grand Mosque and the Sultan Ahmed (Blue) Mosque. Conclude with a walk through the colorful, buzzing Grand Bazaar.

Day 5 | Istanbul | Kayseri | Göreme National Park | Cavusin | Ürgüp

Check out this morning and fly to Kayseri. Arrive and transfer to Cappadocia, celebrated for its astounding and otherworldly rocky landscape.

Göreme National Park. Within this captivating open-air museum, step inside small churches that were carved out of the rocks by a former monastic community and decorated with frescoes in the Byzantine period. Later, marvel at Love Valley's whimsical fairy chimneys and charming Cavusin, a village cut into the rocks. Check in to the Yunak Evleri Cave Hotel in Ürgüp. Tonight, gather for drinks and dinner, and watch a lovely sunset over Cappadocia.

Day 6 | Devrent Valley | Ozkonak | Avanos

🌐 **Elective | Cappadocia Hot Air Balloon Ride.** Float over the incredible, multicolored terrain on an unforgettable sunrise journey.

Devrent Valley. See formations that resemble animals and objects in this scenic region.

🌐 **AHI Connects | Lunch in a Cappadocia Home.** Be welcomed into a private home and enjoy authentic dishes prepared by your hosts.

Ozkonak Underground City. Take a guided tour of a subterranean network of chambers that sheltered thousands from enemy raids.

Avanos Pottery Workshop. Watch skilled potters shape pieces out of the local red clay and learn about their techniques and designs.

Day 7 | Ürgüp | Kayseri | Izmir | Ephesus | Bodrum | Embark gulet

Check out today and head to Kayseri for your flight to Izmir. Arrive and travel to Ephesus.

Ephesus. Appreciate the well-preserved ruins of this acclaimed ancient city, which was a major trading port for the Greeks and the Romans. During your guided tour, admire the impressive Great Theater that could seat 25,000 spectators, the grand, second-century Library of Celsus, the Terrace Houses adorned with mosaics, as well as other stately gems.

After lunch, visit the House of the Virgin Mary, a Catholic shrine, before embarking the Gulet Boreas in Bodrum. Savor dinner on board.

Sedir (Cleopatra) Island, Turquoise Coast

Day 8 | Cruising | Yaliciftlik | Etrim | Çati Bay

Relish the Turquoise Coast's picture-perfect coastal splendor as the yacht sails to Yaliciftlik. Disembark and travel by motor coach to Etrim.

Etrim. Stroll through this peaceful Anatolian mountain village and learn about enduring traditions like carpet and kilim weaving.

Free Time: Unwind this afternoon as the yacht cruises to Çati Bay, where it will overnight.

Day 9 | Cruising | Cleopatra Island | English Harbor

Cleopatra Island & English Harbor. Delight in these idyllic, tranquil spots where the yacht drops anchor and leisure time for swimming and other activities in the pristine waters.

Tonight, join your fellow travelers for a Farewell Reception and Dinner on the yacht.

Day 10 | Karacasöğüt | Disembark gulet | Dalyan | Dalaman | Istanbul

After breakfast, disembark in Karacasöğüt and transfer to Dalyan, where you'll travel on a small boat along the Dalyan Strait to Kaunos.



Lycian Tombs of Kaunos. Gaze up at the striking, Grecian-inspired temple tombs cut high into the rugged cliffs during a guided tour of the archaeological ruins of this ancient city. Continue to Dalaman and fly to Istanbul. Upon arrival, check in to the Barceló Istanbul Hotel.


Free Time: Enjoy your final evening in Istanbul.

Day 11 | In Transit

After breakfast, transfer  to the airport for the return flight  to your gateway city.
