

Program Overview

Days 1-2 In Transit | Vienna, Austria

Depart your gateway city for Vienna, Austria. Arrive and transfer to the Adiago Vienna City. Later, enjoy a Welcome Reception and Dinner.

Days 3-6 Vienna

Rise to a group breakfast on Day 3, followed by a neighborhood orientation tour and a satisfying lunch of local dishes. Day 4 starts with an enriching lecture about Vienna's history. Then, gather for an immersive city tour that includes a panoramic drive along the Ringstrasse, a Schönbrunn Palace tour and lunch. German Language students begin lessons on Day 5, and Classical Music participants join an illuminating concert hall tour on Day 6.

Days 7-10 Vienna

Follow your own path in Vienna on Day 7. In the afternoon, German Language mentees continue instruction. On Day 8, join an enlightening group tour to Vienna's Winter Riding School and Hofburg Palace's Imperial Apartments. Day 9 offers another educational excursion for Classical Music students and Austrian Cuisine participants enjoy a special outing on Day 10.

Days 11-14 Wachau Valley | Vienna

Begin Day 11 with a group journey through the Wachau Valley to Melk Abbey and Dürnstein. Day 12 invites German Language students to improve their skills and Austrian Cuisine pupils share their passion for food during a cooking class. On Day 13, head off to explore Vienna's Jewish community on a group tour. German Language classes continue in the afternoon. Gather on Day 14 for a lecture on modern Austria, followed by a tasty group dinner.

Days 15-18 Bratislava, Slovakia | Vienna

Journey to Bratislava aboard a catamaran on Day 15. Explore this historic city that is full of museums, galleries and boutiques. On Day 16, Elective Activity participants travel to Salzburg for an exciting two-night stay. Days 17 and 18 are at leisure to craft your own path.

Days 19-22 Vienna

Browse collections at the Kunsthistorisches Museum on Day 19. Later, German Language students gather to practice conversation. On Day 20, Classical Music students enjoy session three and German Language pupils fine-tune their proficiency. On Day 21, Austrian Cuisine participants sip and savor during session three and German Language students celebrate with a final class. Day 22 invites all to raise a toast at a Farewell Reception and Dinner.

Day 23 In Transit

Transfer **O** to the airport for your return flight **O** to your gateway city.



Exploring on Your Own

Discover Vienna's heart during ample leisure time. From soaring St. Stephen's Cathedral to the enticing MuseumsQuartier, soak up centuries of culture at your own pace. Experience Vienna through the lens of its people at coffee houses, bustling weekend markets or traditional würstelstands. Embrace the community spirit at small pubs or larger venues with grand performances. Plus, 2025 marks the 200th anniversary of Strauss, and Vienna will host concerts, lectures and shows.

Public Transportation

Navigate Vienna with your included transit card. The city's user-friendly, safe and reliable public transit system offers signage in English and German and consists of underground metras, trams and buses.

Vienna City & Landmarks

Enjoy included excursions and tours led by local experts that showcase Vienna's sites. Thrill to famous landmarks along the Ringstrasse and tour Schönbrunn Palace, former residence of the Imperial family. Another day takes you to the renowned Kunsthistorisches Museum, filled with impressive art collections.



Spanish Riding School & Hofburg Palace

The Winter Riding School is the magnificent riding hall of the Spanish Riding School, an institution that demands the Renaissance tradition of classical dressage. Watch the harmony between the snowy white Lipizzan stallions and their riders during a training practice. After, tour the sumptuous Imperial Apartments of Hofburg Palace, host to rich decor and exquisite artwork.

Bratislava, Slovakia

Bratislava's historic center boasts rainbowcolored buildings and playful sculptures. See St. Martin's Cathedral and St. Michael's Gate, and enter Primate's Palace. A visit to Bratislava wouldn't be complete without tasting homemade pastries and wine!

Wachau Valley, Melk Abbey & Dürnstein

Venture outside of Vienna to the UNESCOlisted Wachau Valley, blanketed with vineyards and whimsical villages. Tour Melk's restored Benedictine abbey, a bright yellow baroque building that dates from 1736. After lunch, continue to small, cozy Dürnstein. Walk along its pleasant lanes and witness the magnificent Stiftskirche, known for its soaring blue tower.



Optional Enrichment Tracks

The **Vienna—Art of Living** program offers increased choice and experiences. GERMAN LANGUAGE

Language is one of the most powerful tools for cultural immersion. This track includes nine small-group German language classes. Sessions are typically two hours and are tailored to your skill level, guaranteeing individual attention and a comfortable progression through the lessons. The school can accommodate beginning, intermediate and advanced students.

A professional teacher who uses an established curriculum and teaching methods will lead your language classes. Using the immersion method, your teacher will provide instruction in German only. This may seem daunting at first, but soon, you will find this is a natural learning method as your ears become attuned to listening to German. You will be surprised how much and how quickly you can learn this way!

2 AUSTRIAN CULINARY TRADITIONS

Food is a gateway into a country's culture and soul. This track includes three enriching culinary encounters focusing on typical Austrian wines, ingredients and culinary history. Discover the flavors and traditions that define Austrian cuisine and take home new cooking skills.

Traditional Wine Tavern. Visit a *heuriger* (traditional wine tavern) in the country-side. Enjoy a delicious buffet and sample a variety of wines directly from the makers.

Austrian Cooking Class.

Join a local chef for a handson experience. Discover the defining points of Austrian cuisine while learning to prep a traditional salad, main course and satisfying dessert. After making your meal, enjoy dinner with friends.

Mozartkugel Workshop. Roll up your sleeves and learn how to make authentic *Mozartkugel*, a delightful confection made from pistachio marzipan, nougat, hazelnuts and almonds.
