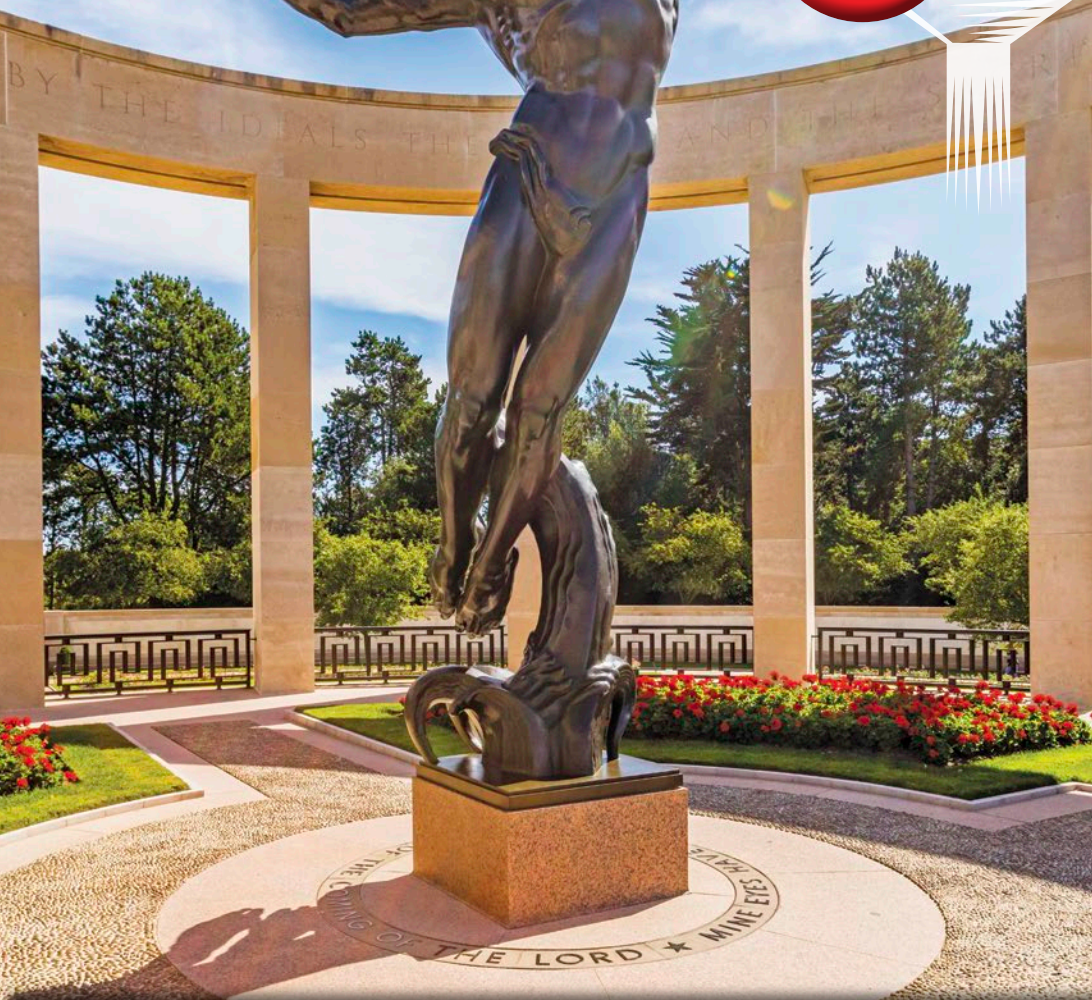

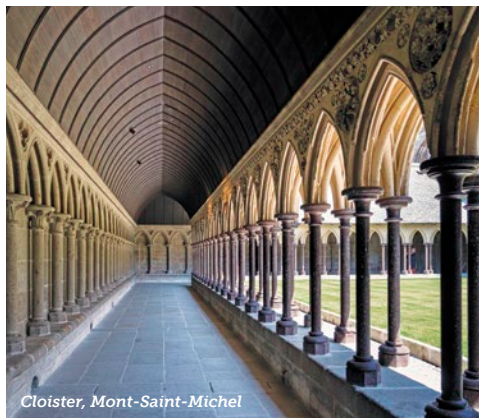

- Delight in the local color and tasty cuisine along **Honfleur's picturesque harbor**.
- Savor lunch and a wine tasting at a stately **10th-century castle**.
- Venture to **charming Bayeux** to visit its magnificent Norman-Gothic cathedral.
- Discover the impact of World War II at the **Caen Memorial Museum**.
- Sip **Calvados**, Normandy's celebrated cider brandy, on a Norman estate.
- Feel the sea breeze during a walk along the cliffs of **Étretat**.
- Experience the **UNESCO World Heritage site** of **Mont-Saint-Michel**, a marvelous tidal island.



Honfleur

Day 1 | In Transit

Depart your gateway city for Paris, France. 🌍

Day 2 | Paris, France | Honfleur

Arrive and transfer 🔄 to the hotel for check in. Meet and mingle with your fellow travelers at this evening's Welcome Reception at the hotel, followed by dinner at a local restaurant.

Day 3 | Honfleur

Historic Honfleur Walking Tour. Stroll with your guide through this captivating port town that has inspired artists for centuries. Honfleur was an important trading seaport between the 16th and 18th centuries. Soak up the maritime charm of the 17th-century Vieux Bassin harbor, surrounded by high, narrow half-timber houses. Stroll the narrow side streets and squares past cafes and artisan shops and admire landmarks, such as the wooden, 15th-century Church of Sainte Catherine, crafted by shipbuilders.

Free Time: Find a café for lunch and explore more of Honfleur at your leisure.

Enrichment: *The French Resistance.* Delve into the origins, leaders and the heroic efforts of the French patriots who fought to liberate their country.

Savor regional specialties together for dinner at a local restaurant in Honfleur tonight.

Day 4 | Arromanches | Omaha Beach | Colleville-sur-Mer | Pointe du Hoc

Enrichment: *D-Day & Battle of Normandy.*

Learn about the critical role Normandy played during this crucial period of the war effort while aboard the coach en route to Arromanches.

D-Day & the Battle of Normandy. Journey along the coast and stop at Pegasus Bridge, captured by the Allies on D-Day. Tour the Arromanches Landing Museum and see the remains of an artificial, offshore mulberry harbour, a feat of engineering built by the Allies to facilitate the rapid unloading of resources, including troops and supplies, into France.

Break for lunch and continue to Omaha Beach. See the poignant Le Braves Memorial and the Signal Monument, honoring the courageous soldiers who landed there on D-Day to advance under devastating fire across the heavily fortified shoreline to overcome German troops.

Then, in Colleville-sur-Mer, pay a poignant visit

to the Normandy American Cemetery. Set on a beautiful bluff overlooking Omaha Beach, the cemetery contains 9,385 graves of Americans who died in the invasion and subsequent battles, as well as a tranquil memorial garden honoring those missing in action.

Visit Pointe du Hoc, where U.S. Rangers scaled 100-foot cliffs to destroy German artillery. Understand the treacherous mission and see a German defensive displacement.

Day 5 | Étretat | Château du Bec

Étretat & Château du Bec. Cross the Seine River estuary on the Pont de Normandie, which was the world's longest cable-stayed bridge when it opened in 1995. It remains the longest bridge in France. Continue to Étretat and its famed white cliffs, which inspired Delacroix, Courbet, Monet and Matisse, among others. See the Porte d'Aval rock arch and L'Aiguille, the needle of rock jutting out of the ocean. Next, visit the Château du Bec, a 10th-century castle on a wooded 35-acre Norman estate. One of the owners will

welcome you to their home during your visit of the home and grounds. Then, relish lunch and local wines in this idyllic setting.

Day 6 | Mont-Saint-Michel

Mont-Saint-Michel. With one glimpse of Mont-Saint-Michel's striking silhouette rising above the surrounding flat sands, you'll quickly understand why this captivating tidal island is considered a wonder of the Western world. Visit the tranquil abbey that has drawn pilgrims for centuries. Marvel at its Romanesque and Gothic architecture and contemplate its place as a symbol of faith and resilience. *(Active)*

Free Time: Find a café for lunch on your own and relish some free time to meander along the ramparts or the charming, lively streets.

Day 7 | Caen | Bayeux

Caen Peace Memorial. At this award-winning museum, gain an international perspective of World War II, the D-Day landings, the Battle of Normandy and the Cold War. View artifacts, photographs and video footage that focus on the war's global impact and the importance



of remembrance, reconciliation and peace.

AHI Connects | Norman Estate Lunch & Calvados Tasting. Normandy's apple cider brandy is among the world's finest. Visit an estate that distills Calvados from the apples grown on its orchards to learn about the process. Then, sit down to a delicious lunch with a tasting of smooth Calvados.

Bayeux. Journey to Bayeux to visit its Notre Dame Cathedral, the Cathedral of Our Lady of Bayeux, consecrated in 1077 and considered a masterpiece of Norman Gothic architecture. Then, enjoy time at leisure in this little town to explore its charming boutiques and cafés.

Day 8 | Honfleur



Free Time: Your final day is yours to plan! Visit nearby museums, such as the Musée Eugène Boudin; stroll through local markets and along the sea walls; or savor lunch as you take in the local scene from a waterfront café.

This evening, raise a toast to your enriching time in Normandy with your fellow travelers at a Farewell Reception and Dinner.

Day 9 | In Transit

After breakfast, transfer  to the Paris airport for the return flight  to your gateway city.

Normandy & D-Day

Over 80 years ago, one of history's most significant, complex invasions unfolded along Normandy's coastline. It began on D-Day, June 6, 1944, when more than 160,000 Allied forces arrived by air and sea, landing in territory held by the Germans. Under the command of General Dwight D. Eisenhower, the Allied troops faced fierce resistance and sustained thousands of casualties, but they succeeded in securing the beaches and later advanced inland to liberate Paris. It was a tactical and psychological blow to Hitler and his troops, and D-Day will forever be remembered as the moment of World War II when the tide began to turn against the Nazis.

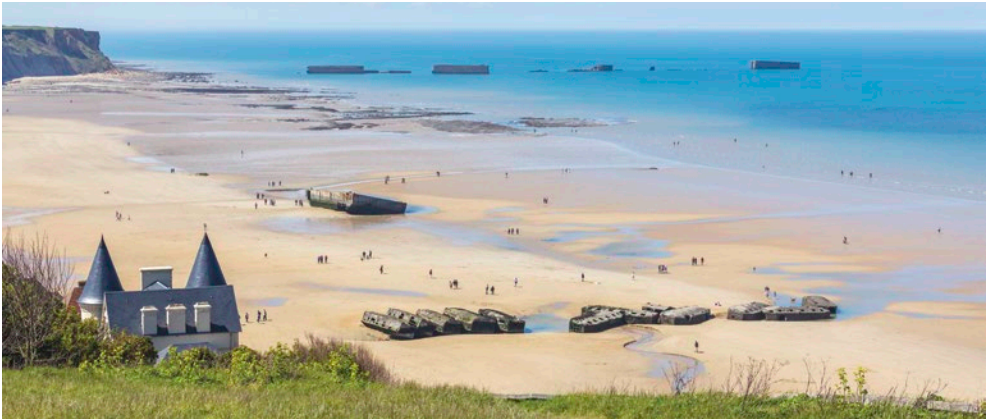

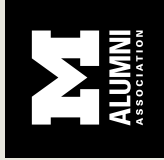
