

#### Day 1| In Transit

Depart for Dubrovnik, Croatia.

#### Day 2 | Dubrovnik, Croatia

Upon arrival, transfer **3** and embark the ship. Take time to unpack and get to know your ship's amenities. Later tonight, gather for a convivial Welcome Reception and Dinner.

#### Day 3 | Dubrovnik | Mali Ston & Ston

**Enchanting Dubrovnik.** The adventure begins! Start the day by discovering this historic city by the sea. Witness the Pile Gate, Europe's oldest working pharmacy and the Franciscan Monastery's cloister. See the medieval Sponza Palace and view a baroque cathedral with its collections of art and religious relics.

After free time, head back to the boat and refresh over a lunch of regional cuisine.

Idyllic Pelješac Peninsula. Beloved for its stunning beauty, the rugged Pelješac Peninsula is abundant with fjords, quiet bays and vineyards. Today, gain insight into a centuries-old practice while visiting some of the world's oldest salt harvesting sites. Also, see the Great Wall of Ston, which links Ston to Mali Ston.

**Connects** | *Mali Ston Oyster Farm.* Board a boat in the fishing village of Mali Ston. Ride across the bay to visit an oyster farm. Taste delicious bivalves, fresh from the sea, accompanied by sensational wine.

Meet up with your group for a Captain's Dinner.

#### Day 4 | Korčula

Settle on a sunny deck while sailing to Korčula. **Korčula.** This spectacular isle, which is rumored

to be the birthplace of Marco Polo, juts into the Pelješac Channel and brims with natural wonders. Join a guide for a walk through the old town, filled with enduring architecture.

#### Day 5 | Hvar

After a satisfying breakfast, cruise on to Hvar.

Hvar's Stari Grad. Uncover a slice of paradise in the ancient port town of Stari Grad, Croatia's oldest town. Admire the churches, quaint squares and orange-tiled rooftops clustered around the charming marina.

**AHI Connects** | *Lavender Farm.* Soak up the purple beauty and delightful fragrance of lavender during a visit to a family-run lavender farm in Jesla. The blossoms are grown for medical, cosmetic, cooking and other products.

**Vrboska & Winery.** Learn about the local viniculture at a family winery and enjoy a guided tasting of the family's legendary wines. Continue to the fishing town of Vrboska with fig-covered courtyards and pretty alleyways.

#### Day 6 | Split

While cruising to Split, breathe in salty air and revel in lovely far-off islands on the horizon.

**Split.** Behold Split's many riches while walking through the courtyards and chambers of Diocletian's Palace. See the Cathedral of Saint Domnius, the Golden Gate and the Peristyle.

Craft your own path during time at leisure.

#### Day 7 | Šibenik

Šibenik. Šibenik is a proud city that welcomes visitors with winding alleys, squares and striking buildings. Visit the UNESCO-listed Cathedral of St. James, one of Europe's most significant monumental churches.

#### Day 8 | Zadar

Raise a toast over lunch accompanied by a Farewell Cocktail Reception.

that is home to an impressive Roman Forum and the Church of St. Donatus. Sample unique Maraschino cherry liquor and other locally made sweets. The first recipes of the Maraschino liquor emerged from Zadar during the 16th century.

**Free Time:** Perhaps return to see the famous sea organ and light show by the promenade.

#### Day 9 | Zadar | Plitvice Lakes National Park | Zagreb

Disembark your ship after breakfast. Head inland to tour Plitvice Lakes National Park.

**Plitvice Lakes National Park.** This park features 16 crystal-clear terraced lakes linked by a series of waterfalls. Wander along planked walkways and trails amid a fragrant forest. The area is also home to nearly 160 species of birds and numerous plant species. After a lunch of regional dishes, continue to Zagreb and check in to the hotel.

#### Day 10 | **Zagreb**

#### Enrichment: Contemporary Croatia.

**Zagreb Panoramic Tour.** Zagreb weaves European elegance with a vivacious Balkan spirit. After a panoramic tour of the lower town, drive to Mirogoj Cemetery, designed by architect Hermann Bollé. Tour the cemetery, then return to the well-preserved upper town.

#### Day 11 | Zagreb

**Free Time:** Make your own discoveries in Zagreb today or join our elective excursion.

(Felective | *Ljubljana, Slovenia*. Cross into Slovenia to discover colorful Ljubljana. Stroll along the Ljubljanica River, passing iconic bridges, shop like a local at the Central Market and browse Prešeren Square, home to the Franciscan Church of the Annunciation. Then, enjoy a cruise along the Ljubljanica River. Gather for a Farewell Reception and Dinner.

After breakfast, transfer **>** to the airport for the return flight **\$** to your gateway city.


