A World of Discovery

Afro-Cuban Havana. Join writer/activist Roberto Zurbarano on a guided walk of Old Havana as he shares insights into Cuba's Afro-Cuban and mestizo culture. Stop at Beyond Roots, an independent shop that celebrates and promotes Afro style and identity, to speak with the inspiring staff.

Afro-Cuban Spirituality. Visit two Havana strongholds of deep-rooted Afro-Cuban religious traditions. See the Black Madonna at the Church of Our Lady in Regla. Then, in Guanabacoa, visit with a Babalawo high priest to learn about Ifá practices and savor a traditional Afro-Cuban lunch in his home.

Cuban Literacy Campaign. Meet social psychologist Norma Guillard to watch the documentary, "Maestra." Hear about her vital work, teaching and writings in support of literacy, LGBTQ rights and women's issues, followed by an engaging discussion.

National Museum of Fine Arts. Wilfredo Benítez Munõz of the Ludwig Foundation guides you through the Cuban art museum.

El Callejón de Hamel. Visit this alley, filled with rumba, art and Afro-Cuban culture.

Cuban Cultural Immersion. Begin at the Ashkenazi Synagogue to uncover Havana's Jewish culture. Then, interact with Malpaso Dance Company's elite dancers and watch them rehearse. Visit women-owned shops to discuss female entrepreneurship in Cuba. Later, engage with emerging Cuban artists at the nonprofit Ludwig Foundation.

Matanzas & The Slave Route. Enjoy a scenic drive to this cultural-rich city. Admire the elegant French Quarter and the bygone beauty of Spanish colonial mansions. Pause for a lively local choir performance, stroll through La Libertad Park to witness Cuban freedom monuments, and tour a preserved 1882 French-style pharmacy. Explore the San Severino Castle, circa 1735, and the Sugar Mill Museum, site of the 1843 Slave Rebellion — along Cuba's Slave Route.

Agromercado & Art Studio. Take a walk to experience daily Cuban life at a lively street market. Visit Casa Fuster, the home and studio of Picasso-inspired Cuban artist José Fuster. See his vibrant mosaics, learn about his work and enjoy an engaging lunch here.

Vintage Convertible Ride. Cruise in a privately owned 1950s American convertible along Havana's Malecón. Peek under the hood and chat with your friendly driver while learning about Cuban resourcefulness.

Afro-Cuban Dance. Cuban dancers share their passion for salsa—with dance tips!

Las Terrazas. Travel to rural Cuba to this model socialist community. Stop by various businesses, interact with local residents and savor a lunch with locally grown vegetables.
