

Day 1 | In Transit

Depart your gateway city for Lisbon, Portugal.

Day 2 | Lisbon, Portugal

Arrive in Lisbon and transfer **3** to your hotel. Tonight, gather for a Welcome Reception.

Day 3 | Lisbon

Lisbon City Tour. Begin today along the Avenida de Liberdade. Next, uncover Portugal's history at the Hieronymites Monastery, where sailors and explorers prayed before their expeditions. Also admire the artistry of the towering Monument to the Discoveries and the Belém Tower, which celebrates the triumphs of Portugal's explorers. Continue to the district of Estrela to glimpse local life.

Free Time: Discover Lisbon at your own pace. Telective | Fado Dinner. Savor a delicious dinner of Portuguese cuisine and listen to soul-stirring fado, a traditional genre of music with guitar and vocal arrangements.

Day 4 | Lisbon

Free Time: Join today's elective excursion to explore nearby villages or enjoy a day at leisure. Flective | Sintra, Cascais & Estoril. Sintra boasts bright architecture and the celebrated National Palace of Sintra. Walk in the footsteps of Portuguese kings during a guided tour of the palace. Next, take a scenic drive and pass Cabo da Roca and Guincho Beach. Stop in the vibrant town of Cascais for a guided walk, and drive through Estoril on your return to Lisbon.

Enrichment: Contemporary Portugal.

Day 5 | Óbidos | Coimbra | Porto

Check out of your hotel after breakfast.

Óbidos. Explore one of the most beautiful towns in Portugal! Óbidos sits on top of a coastal hill and is filled with brightly colored bougainvillea and geraniums.

Coimbra. Coimbra's timeworn streets offer a variety of interesting monuments and landmarks. Visit the illustrious University of Coimbra, one of Europe's oldest universities. See St. Michael's Chapel, a historic ceremonial hall and the stunning Biblioteca Joanina.

After a group lunch, continue to Porto and embark your ship. Later, join a festive onboard Welcome Reception and Dinner.

Day 6 | Porto | Peso da Régua

• Porto City Tour. Explore Porto's historic and modern districts, viewing architectural styles

at the Palácio da Bolsa. Visit the Igreja de São Francisco and enjoy a port wine tasting.

 Porto by Tram & Flavors of Porto. See the city from a unique perspective aboard one of its old trams. Visit the Museu do Carro Eléctrico, followed by a tasting of local foods.

Free Time: The afternoon is at leisure. You're welcome to return to the city center on the complimentary shuttle.

Enrichment: Douro Wine Country.

Musical Tuna. Enjoy a "Tuna" band, a group of local students who sing serenades.

Day 7 | Porto

PYJ | Choose one of these excursions:

- Guimarães, Cradle of Portugal. Discover the birthplace of Portugal's first king on a walking tour. Step inside Igreja de Nossa Senhora da Oliveira and visit the Palace of the Dukes of Bragança, an opulent estate.
- Coastal Walk & Afurada. Take a guided walk along the coastline and river. Pass through the fishing village of São Pedro da Afurada

on a route with a beautiful view of Porto and Ribeira Square. Continue to a port wine cellar for a tasting. (Active)

This afternoon, begin cruising the Douro River.

Day 8 | Peso da Régua | Barca d'Alva

Mateus Palace. Learn about the historic Douro winemaking region during a museum visit and explore the Solar de Mateus, a baroque palace. Cruise to Barca d'Alva and take in sweeping views of multicolored vineyards along the river.

Sevillanas. Gather for a fun dancing show.

Day 9 | Salamanca, Spain

PYJ | Choose one of these excursions:

- Salamanca City Tour. Explore the notable university town of Salamanca. Visit the ornate cathedral and tour the famous university.
- Salamanca Tapas Tour. Join a guide for a tasty Spanish tapas tour. Sample typical bites and sip a glass of locally produced wine.

Day 10 | São João da Pesqueira, Portugal | Pinhão

Porto's Wine Road. Travel through the rolling Alto Douro wine region. Join a walking tour of São João da Pesqueira before exploring at your leisure. Continue to a traditional country estate, or quinta, for a tour of the facilities and a tasting of the local product.

Portuguese Folklore. Cap off the evening with an authentic folk performance.

Day 11 | Lamego | Porto

Lamego. Pretty Lamego is nestled in the heart of the port-producing Douro Valley. Visit Nossa Senhora dos Remédios, a splendid baroque church overlooking the city. Leading to the church is a grand staircase with 686 steps, nine landings, statues, obelisks and azulejos, Portugal's iconic blue-and-white tiles. Return to the ship and cruise to Porto.

Tonight, celebrate your exciting journey at a Farewell Reception and Dinner.

Day 12 | In Transit

After breakfast, disembark the ship and transfer **3** to the airport for the return flight **4** to your gateway city.


