A World of Discovery

AHI Connects | Czech Brewery Tour and Tasting. Visit a local brewery to learn about the Czech Republic's distinctive strong beers and lagers and savor beer tastings!

Prague's Old Town. Set out on a guided walk in this historic capital known as the City of a Thousand Spires. Stroll the heart of the old town with its colorful buildings, Gothic cathedrals and famed Astronomical Clock, installed in 1410, where you'll stop to witness the hourly "Walk of the Apostles."

Cruise the VItava River. Embark on the riverboat and depart Prague. Begin your cruise by passing under the iconic Charles Bridge, admiring the spectacular skyline, dotted with medieval towers, church spires and the majestic Prague Castle.

Konopiště Castle. Cruise to Štěchovice to visit this 13th-century fortress, once the House of Habsburg's hunting lodge, and an example of French-influenced fortification architecture. Marvel at the large collection of medieval armor and weapons that belonged to the late Archduke Franz Ferdinand of Austria, and stroll the surrounding gardens.

Prague Castle Tour. Visit Prague Castle, seat of Czech rulers since the 9th century. Admire the Castle Square gate, the Castle Gallery and and the16th-century Golden Lane, where Czech writer Franz Kafka lived. Pass by the Old Royal Palace and tour the castle's crown jewel, the Gothic St. Vitus Cathedral, stepping inside St. Wenceslas Chapel, a symbol of Czech identity.

Prague's Historic Jewish Quarter. Take a guided walk to discover Prague's Jewish life over the centuries. Tour the National Jewish Museum, the Old-New Synagogue and the world's oldest Jewish cemetery.

Cruise the Elbe River. Cruise this scenic river from Bohemia toward Germany, gliding by charming villages, lush vineyards and Mělník Castle before reaching the steep hills and cliffs near the Czech-German border.

Nelahozeves Castle. Stop in Kralupy to visit one of Bohemia's finest Renaissance castles and home to 23 Bohemian princesses and queens. Inside, marvel at the rich collection of furniture and paintings by Dutch masters, belonging to the House of Lobkowicz. Gain a sense of the Baroque-period luxurious lifestyle of the oldest, most eminent, noble Bohemian family nobility. Then, enjoy a tour and tasting of Czech wines at a nearby winery.

Dresden City Tour. Cruise to Mělník and take a panoramic motor coach and walking tour of Dresden's treasures. View historic castles across the Elbe River; the landmark Blue Wonder cantilever truss bridge, and the posh residential area of Weisser Hirsch. Then, on a guided walk in the heart of this royal capital, see the Church of Our Lady, Royal Catholic Cathedral and Royal Castle. Marvel at the baroque Dresden Zwinger complex and the historic Taschenbergpalais Hotel, followed by an inside visit to the Green Vault museum or the Old Master's Gallery.

Litoměřice Tour. Visit one Bohemia's oldest cities, established in the 10th century on the site of a Slavic fortress near the confluence of the Elbe and Ohře rivers. See architectural gems, such as the Gothic Old Town Hall, the Baroque Bishop's Palace and the elegant, Romanesque St. Stephen's Cathedral.
